New and Returning Applicant Guidelines

Our electronic application is available [online](#) starting Aug 2. **Do not** forward this email or share this link. You must create a user profile at the link provided or sign in using your existing account. *If you have an existing account, your username has been updated to include .leg at the end of your email address. If you are a county judge or prosecutor signing up for the first time, you may select any county or office in which you are applying for while registering an account.* Once logged in, you may then apply for the specific grant for which you are authorized. If you are having problems signing into the portal, please contact our office at SB22.Grants@cpa.texas.gov.

Counties and prosecutor's offices with fiscal years that start on Oct 1 may apply for grant funds beginning Aug 2. Applications must be submitted no later than Oct 31, 2026. If your county or office received grant funds from the last grant period, you must submit a compliance report. Compliance reports will open Oct 1, 2026 until Dec1, 2026.
