



AMENDMENT TO COURT PAYMENT CARD PROCESSING PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

This amendment ("Amendment") is effective as of the date of signature of the last party to sign as indicated below ("Amendment Effective Date"), by and between Tyler Technologies, Inc. ("Tyler"), a Delaware corporation, and Burnet County Court ("Court").

WHEREAS, Tyler and the Court are parties to a certain Court Payment Card Processing Participation Agreement dated March 18, 2014 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS Tyler and the Court desire to amend the Agreement to allow acceptance of payment of fees related to electronic filing by electronic check ("eCheck");

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein, Tyler and the Court agree as follows:

1. Tyler shall assess Registered Users a \$.25 fee per electronic payment transaction initiated via eCheck, in lieu of the Per Transaction Convenience Fee assessed for credit or debit card payments.
2. Tyler shall not verify or otherwise guarantee funds for payments made via eCheck are available or sufficient in consumer's bank account. A \$20.00 fee shall be assessed to the Registered User for each non-sufficient funds transaction received. Such fee shall be paid to Tyler.
3. The Court will, separate and apart from this Amendment, amend its Member Bank Agreement to allow payments from \$0.01 to \$10,000 via eCheck. Tyler's obligations under this Amendment are contingent upon Court so amending its Member Bank Agreement.
4. Only the terms related to electronic filing are amended hereby.
5. This Amendment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
6. All terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
