Deputies routinely answer calls for service to assist motorists throughout Burnet County. In many cases the stranded motorist (women and elderly) has a flat tire and needs assistance in changing the tire. Many factory jacks are inadequate for the task in areas of soft or uneven terrain, putting the motorist and/or deputy in added danger. By carrying these floor jacks and other requested equipment deputies will be able to change the flats faster and with greater safety.

This request will equip every marked Sheriff's Office vehicle with a jack and 4 way tire tool along with providing each deputy with a set of gloves.
