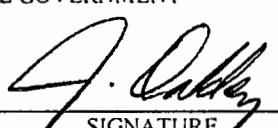

To increase the current per diem rate of \$59.26 to \$64.00 and the guard/transportation rate of \$18.00 to \$24.00. 2. To correct the IGA number on Modification 5 dated August 29, 2017 from 80-98-0024 to 80-11-0007. The firm-fixed per-diem rate for services is stipulated in block #9 AND #10 of this modification, shall not be subject to adjustment on the basis of the Burnet County Jail actual cost experience in providing the service. The per-diem rate and guard/transportation rate shall be fixed for a period from the effective date of this modification forward for forty-eight (48) months. The per-diem rate covers the support of one Federal detainee per "Federal detainee day", which shall include the day of arrival, but not the day of departure.
