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Proposal for Burnet County Solicitation No. 119-4090-07

Purpose:

The purpose of this proposal is to develop and implement a comprehensive refrigerant recovery program between Burnet County and Rapid Recovery which is beneficial to both and supportive of each entity's goal.

Key Elements of Proposal:

1. Pricing for the service of recovering refrigerant from various refrigerated equipment.
2. Contact information for whom to contact with jobs.

Tank Service Charges:

There will be recovery charges for all Tank Service recoveries conducted for all Burnet County locations. The recovery charges will be based upon the size of the cylinders and the refrigerant type and purity.

- a. 30/50lb recovery cylinders will be billed at \$30.00/cylinder.
- b. 125lb cylinders will be billed at \$75.00/cylinder.
- c. 240lb cylinders will be billed at \$150.00/cylinder.
- d. 500/1,000lb cylinders will be billed at \$300.00/cylinder.

Job Site Recovery Charges:

1. Jobsite recoveries are billed based upon the size of the units being recovered. The cost is based upon the data plate full charge data not upon the actual amount of refrigerant recovered from the unit. Buy-back (if any) is based upon the purity and actual (gross) weight of refrigerant recovered (see requirements in the next section of this agreement).
2. Pricing for all RTU and Chillers will be based upon the following schedule.
3. The minimum mobilization fee will be \$200. If the project exceeds this minimum, there will be no charge for mobilization.

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Refrigerant Buy-back and Pricing

1. Buy-back of all refrigerants will be based upon the purity and actual weight of the refrigerant recovered. To receive the maximum buy-back pricing for refrigerant, it must be a minimum of 97% purity. The actual purity and weight of the refrigerant will be determined at the time of the recovery. The refrigerants being recovered will be tested, on-site for purity (when applicable) as well as the actual weight of refrigerant recovered will be determined. The actual amount of the refrigerant recovered will be based upon the gross amount of refrigerant recovered, including oils and particulate.
2. Buy-back is based upon the current market value on the day the recovery is completed and is a number that fluctuates on somewhat of a regular basis. Usually the buy-back price is set by the 5th of each month and this price can go up or down based upon the current market conditions. The frequency of change can happen at any time based on those market conditions.
3. Refrigerant buy-back will be put toward the service cost or the purchase cost of new refrigerant, if requested.

Refrigerant Purchase Price:

Refrigerant purchase price is based upon the current market value on the day the refrigerant is purchased and is a price that fluctuates on somewhat of a regular basis. Usually the purchase price is set by the 5th of each month and this price can go up or down based upon the current market conditions. The frequency of change can happen at any time based on those market conditions. Refrigerant buy-back will be put toward the service cost or the purchase of new refrigerant, if requested.

Mixed Refrigerant disposal fees:

Waived for Burnet County locations. This represents a \$3.00/lb. value to Burnet County for mixed refrigerants that would normally require destructions fees.

EPA Required Documentation:

1. All EPA required documentation will be completed by Rapid Recovery technicians as required by EPA regulations. This documentation will be made available to Burnet County on an as need basis, but at a minimum Rapid Recovery will provide this documentation on an annual basis, usually by the middle of February of the year following recoveries.
2. On an as requested basis, all recovery documentation will be sent to the Burnet County. Documentation will normally arrive within 30 days after the recovery is completed.

Technician and Equipment Certifications:

1. All technicians are certified under EPA 608 Universal regulations and certification requirements. The current EPA 608 certification changes will be applicable effective January 1, 2018 going forward.
2. All Recovery equipment used during each recovery is certified according to all AHRI certification standards and requirements of the Refrigerant Recovery/Recycling



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Equipment Certification Program, a program of the Air-Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute.

Payment Terms:

1. Payment terms will be net-45 days from the date of recovery.
2. All Invoicing will be made directly to the County of Burnet.

Insurance / Indemnification:

1. A-Gas and Rapid Recovery will keep in full force and effect insurance coverage, on an occurrence basis (unless otherwise noted), as follows: (i) workers' compensation insurance in the amounts required by applicable law and employer's liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 each accident, \$1,000,000 disease - each employee, and \$1,000,000 disease - policy limit; (ii) automobile liability insurance with limits of at least \$5,000,000 combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence; (iii) commercial general liability insurance with limits of at least \$5,000,000 combined and (iv) contractor pollution liability insurance and/or pollution legal liability insurance as applicable, of at least \$2,000,000 per incident. Pollution liability insurance may be written on a claims made basis. To the extent of A-Gas and Rapid Recovery's indemnity obligations under this Proposal, each of the above policies shall contain a waiver of subrogation in favor of the Burnet County Indemnified Parties (defined below). As respects the Services provided by Rapid Recovery under this Proposal, policies under subsections (ii), (iii) and (iv) shall include the Burnet County Indemnified Parties as additional insureds and shall be primary / non-contributory to the Burnet County Indemnified Parties' insurance coverages.
2. To the fullest extent permitted by law, A-Gas and Rapid Recovery shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the County of Burnet Indemnified Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, losses, liability, lawsuits, liens and judgments, including all reasonable attorneys' fees, costs and expenses (collectively "Claims") which arise from or relate to the Services, or which are alleged to arise from or relate to the Services, including without limitation: personal and property damage claims; vehicle claims, theft claims, employment-related claims of Rapid Recovery employees or, if applicable, the employees of any Rapid Recovery subcontractor. The defense and indemnification obligations hereunder shall survive the expiration or termination of this Proposal. As used herein, the term "Burnet County Indemnified Parties" means: (a) Burnet County; (b) the Burnet County Client, property manager, property owner or other person or entity receiving services from Burnet County at locations Rapid Recovery is to service under this Proposal; and (c) the agents, officers, directors, representatives and employees of each person or entity falling under the foregoing categories (a) and (b).

Mileage and Per/Diem:

1. Mileage requirements will be charged on all recoveries that **are more than 100 miles** from the closest Rapid Recovery location or city center of Austin, TX. Mileage over 100 miles will be billed from city center to city center as normal mileage would be.
2. All mileage is based upon city center to city center mileage not mileage from our location to the recovery site location.



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3. All mileage will be charged at \$1.50 per mile. Per Diem requirements will be charged (as required) at the rate of \$200/night should an overnight stay be required. This is based upon the number of hours worked (from the time the technician leaves the Rapid Recovery location until they finish a job). Our technicians are required to operate under CDL -C w/Hazmat endorsement driving regulations which limit our technicians to 8 hours/day.

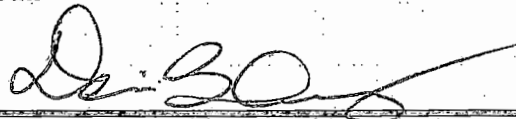

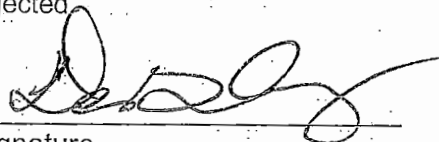
