MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("Memorandum") is executed by and between, BURNET COUNTY, hereinafter referred to as the "County," and the CITY OF GRANITE SHOALS, Texas, hereinafter referred to as the "City," acting by and through their duly authorized representatives. The City is included in the County Emergency Management Plan.

WHEREAS, The City and County experienced a flood event on October 16, 2018, which was officially declared a disaster by both jurisdictions, resulting in damage to property throughout the City of Granite Shoals; and

WHEREAS, The City and County orally agreed on October 18, 2018 to partner in the effort to manage the disposal of flood debris response to the 2018 flood event. This MOU memorializes said agreement in writing;

The parties agree to share in the responsibility to properly collect and dispose of flood debris waste items in response to the flood event and for the duration of the flood recovery timeframe. The County has agreed to procure the contract for debris and hazardous waste removal and will operate the collection site with an approved vendor to collect and properly dispose of items classified as flood debris and household hazardous waste.
