Dear Judge Oakley:

I am pleased to announce that the Lower Colorado River Authority is providing \$100,000 to Burnet County to assist in recovery from the recent historic flooding in the county. A check in that amount is enclosed with this letter. The money is intended to be used for the removal of flood debris to help ensure the health and safety of the public. We leave it up to you as county judge to decide how best to apply the funds to accomplish the debris removal; however, we expect that at least 70% of the funds will be used for the removal of debris that has accumulated within coves and other areas of the water's surface. We do require that the money not be used for the repair or improvement of private property. If you have any questions about how the funds may be used, please don't hesitate to call me or Bill Lauderback at 1-800-776-5272.

I would like a written report from you showing how the money was actually used. We ask that the report be given as soon as possible after all of the funds have been spent.

We wish you success in your ongoing clean-up efforts and stand ready to assist in any way we can.
