

Proclamation

WHEREAS, Texans suffered 171,152 acts of vehicle burglary and 67,658 stolen vehicles in 2019 with July representing one of the months with the most prolific reports of motor vehicle burglary and theft,

WHEREAS, the Burnet County Sheriff's Office, and the Sheriff's Offices from Coryell and Limestone Counties all participate in joint venture known as the Heart of Texas Auto Theft Task Force.

WHEREAS, the Heart of Texas Auto Theft Task Force is funded by a grant from Texas Motor Vehicle Crimes Prevention Authority as well as local support,

WHEREAS, the Heart of Texas Auto Theft Task Force encourages motorists to practice three basic safety tips to help prevent theft and burglary throughout the year: 1. Remove belongings from view 2. Secure vehicles and 3. Never leave keys inside, as well as motorists should park in areas that are well-lit, near surveillance cameras (if available), and near heavy foot and vehicle traffic,

WHEREAS, the Texas Motor Vehicle Crimes Prevention Authority's slogan is "If you like it – LOCK IT" and it has designated July 2019 as "Watch Your Car Month" in Texas

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT WE, THE BURNET COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT, do hereby proclaim the month of July 2019, as

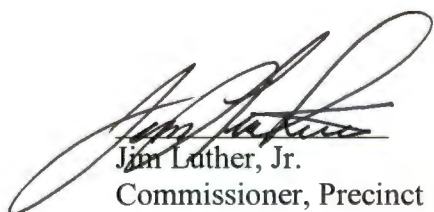
"Watch Your Car Month"

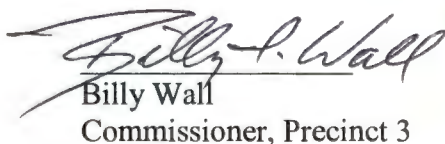

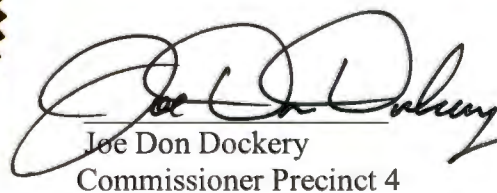
