New MFFR firefighter jumps right into job

 Marble Falls Fire Rescue has a new firefighter among its ranks, Josiah Villarreal, who got a two-alarm welcome to the job on his first day as he was among those on a shift dispatched to a structure fire. Josiah grew up in Brownsville and attended fire academy in Tyler. He also did additional fire training in Sulphur Springs.
