Mr. Jackson,

After the wildfires and flood event of 2018, Burnet County reviewed our Hazard Mitigation Plan. Based on these disasters, the county and the jurisdictions updated the plan. We are submitting the update with the changes highlighted as well as a clean copy. Below is a summary of the updates made to the plan:

- Remove the City of Burnet's Comprehensive review of the City's floodplain management ordinance. Page ES-11 and 19-16.
- City of Marble Falls revised the list of low water crossings for the computer based flood warning system. Pages ES-17 and 19-21.
- City of Marble Falls added raising the primary water intake pumps and control system out of the floodplain. Pages ES-17 and 19-21.
- City of Marble Falls added relocating the wastewater treatment plant out of the floodplain or flood proofing the facility. Pages ES-18 and 19-21.
- City of Marble Falls added replacing the low water crossing on Avenue N at Backbone Creek with a bridge. Pages ES-18 and 19-22.
- City of Marble Falls added replacing the low water crossing on Nature Heights at Whitman Branch Creek with a bridge. ES-18 and 19-22
- City of Marble Falls added replacing the low water crossing on Broadway St. between Ave N & Ave L with a bridge. Pages ES-18 and 19-22.
- City of Marble Falls added relocate the Animal Control Facility out of the floodplain. Pages ES-18 and 19-22.
- City of Marble Falls added replacing the low water crossing on 2<sup>nd</sup> St. at Westside Park with a bridge. Pages ES-19 and 19-22
