

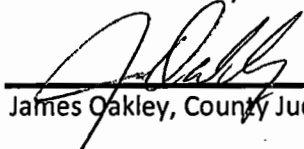


CANVASS OF CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ELECTION

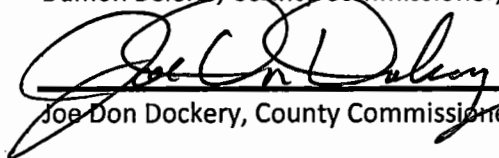
