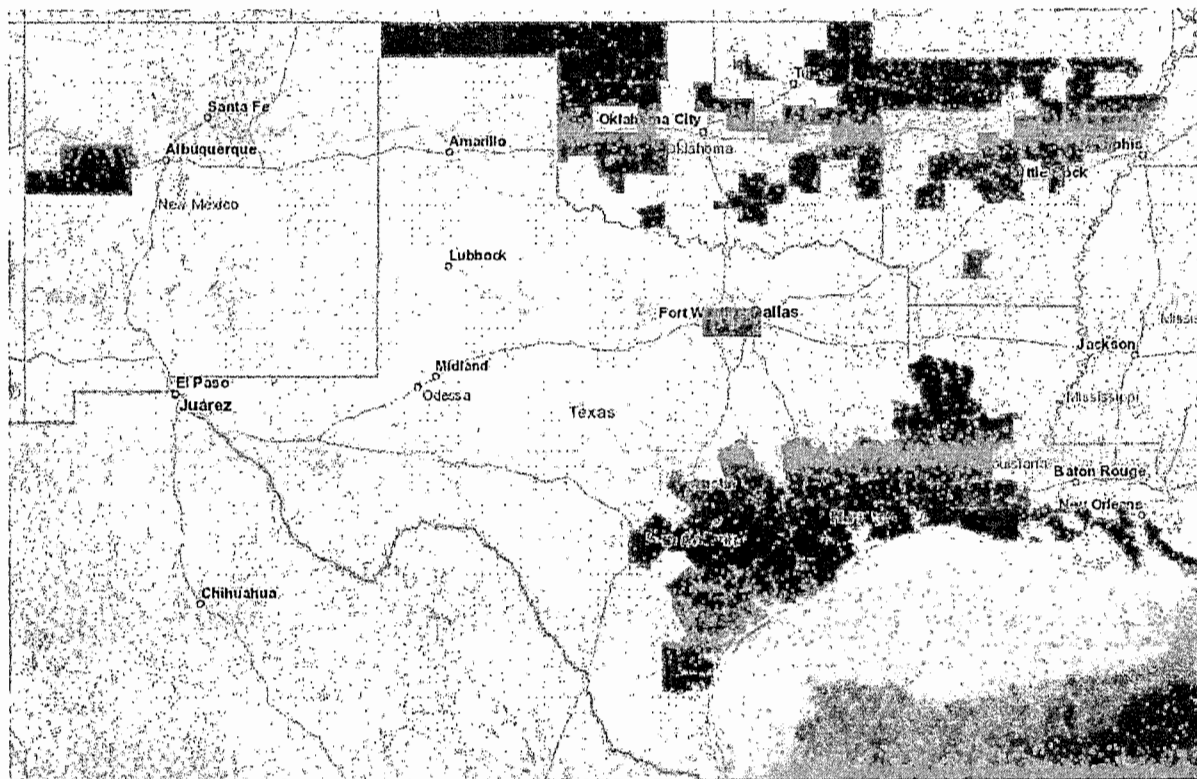

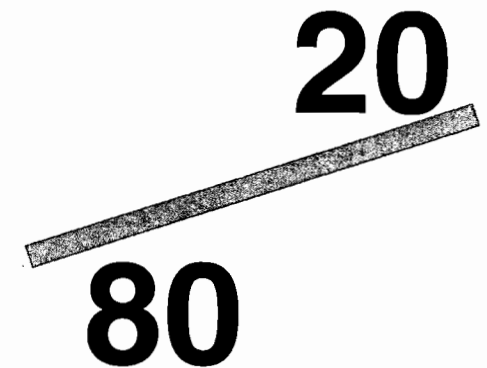

## 2019 AURO REGIONAL FUNDING

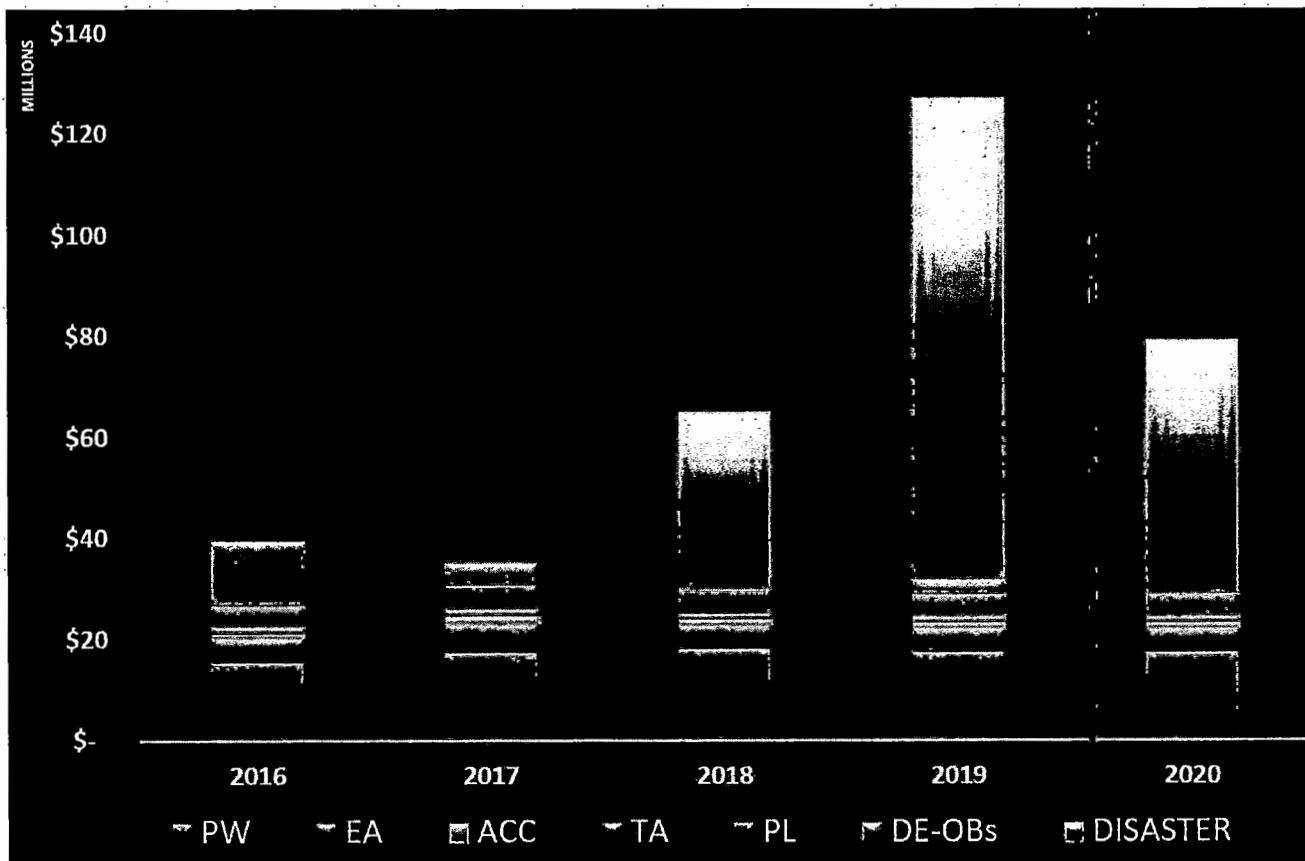

# Funding Categories



## Regional Mitigation:

COG based method of distribution (MOD) to allocate funds to local units of governments and Indian Tribes. The GLO encourages the prioritization of regional investments with regional impacts in risk reduction to develop disaster-resistant infrastructure including upgrading of water, sewer, solid waste, communications, energy, transportation, health and medical infrastructure, and natural mitigation infrastructure. **\$22,000,000 for Region**

***All projects have to be part of an established local Hazard Mitigation Plan by the local jurisdiction.***
