TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

Burnet County received a Community Development Block Grant in 2019 under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program, Disaster Relief Fund, from the Texas Department of Agriculture for removal of debris from the flooding disaster in October 2018.

A public hearing has been called for 5:05 p.m. on Tuesday, May 12, 2020 in the 2nd Floor Courtroom located at 220 S. Pierce, Burnet, TX following proper social distancing guidelines. The purpose of this hearing is to review the program performance of the activities completed under this grant, which will include an explanation of the actual use of the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program funds. Citizens will be entitled to participate and publicly address the County during the hearing.

Burnet County DR Contract #7219017 - Project Summary

PROGRAM PERFORMANCE

Due to severe October 2018 flooding of the Llano River, extreme amounts of natural material and man-made debris littered the communities in Burnet County resulting in a potential threat to public health and safety and limited access to properties.

Community Cleanup

Burnet County performed debris removal and all appurtenant activities to eliminate a potential threat to public safety and improved access. The County removed and disposed of all debris resulting from Llano River flooding in October 2018. Debris removal amounting to 4,619.7 cubic yards occurred from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)-approved site in Granite Shoals. This activity benefitted 41,255 persons, of which 16,730 persons (41%) are of low- to moderate-income.

Grant funds expended for the debris removal and FEMA-required monitoring included \$122,757.96.

General Administration

Grant funds expended for general administration of the grant contract totaled \$19,641.27.
