CENTRAL APPOINTMENT LINE: For families seeking access to services, Bluebonnet Trails offers a central appointment line assisting with information about available services, scheduling, appointments, and navigating through local options for healthcare. CRISIS SERVICES (CS): Our trained staff are dedicated to assisting persons experiencing a crisis. Short-term stabilization stays are available for intensive levels of care through our Extended Observation Units and Crisis Respite Units. Our professional staff are available to talk with you 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through our Crisis Hotline at **1-800-841-1255**.

AUTISM (AS): Our Autism Program provides a family-centered approach teaching individual skills needed to succeed at home, school, and in the community. Our Board Certified Behavior Analysts offer research-based strategies to address compliance, speech, language and life skills, academics, social skills and more within the individual's home and community. You can find our Autism program offered in 10 Central Texas counties.

FAMILY HEALTH CARE (FHC): Our Family Health Care Centers provide a combination of preventative medical care, dental services, mental and emotional healthcare, developmental services, and substance abuse services. Our collaborative healthcare professionals provide care for a healthy body and mind reaching a fulfilled life.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CARE (BHC): For those benefitting from mental healthcare or substance use treatment, our qualified professional psychiatrists, counselors and skilled medical team provide medication management, individual, family and group therapy and coping skills assisting individuals in reaching their desired wellness goals. We offer Outreach, Screening, Assessment and Referral services through our OSAR Program, covering a 30 county area of Central Texas to provide the best options for substance use care. Our licensed substance use counselors work collaboratively with individuals to create a recovery plan based on meaningful goals and intervention supporting individual success and promoting long-term recovery. Key to our success is our peer specialists' unique insight into the recovery journey.

EARLY CHILDHOOD INTERVENTION (ECI): For babies and toddlers from birth to 3 years of age, our Early Childhood Intervention program helps children reach their greatest potential in achieving developmental milestones. Our team focuses on working with families and children in their natural home settings, offering support where children live, learn and play.

INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY (IDD): Our professional staff provides service coordination, diagnostic and evaluation services, community living and skills training, respite and employment services, and counseling. Our team works with families to support the growth of loved ones. Our approach focuses on enriching the individual's life within their community.

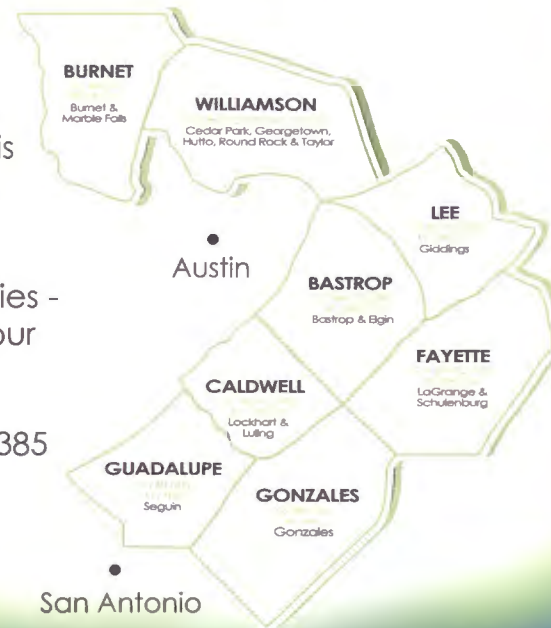

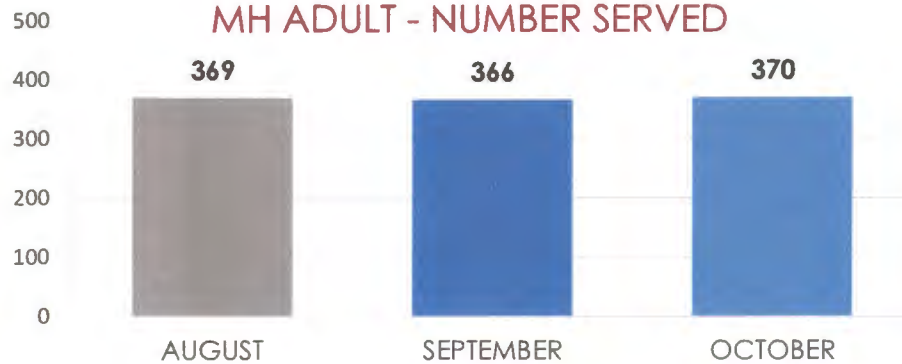

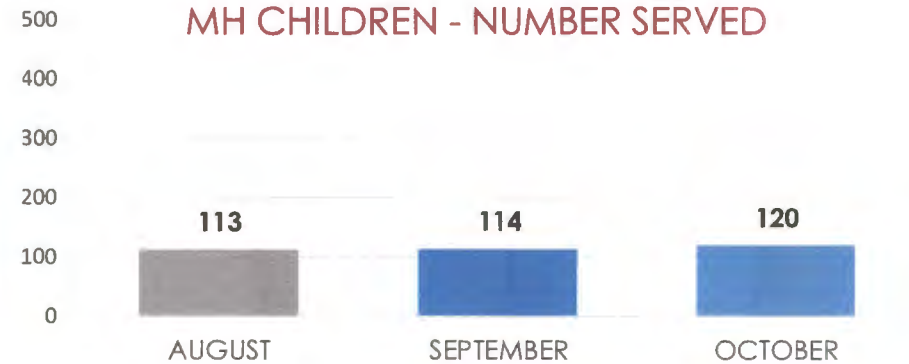
October 2020 Burnet County Services Dashboard

TOTAL SERVED BY PROGRAM

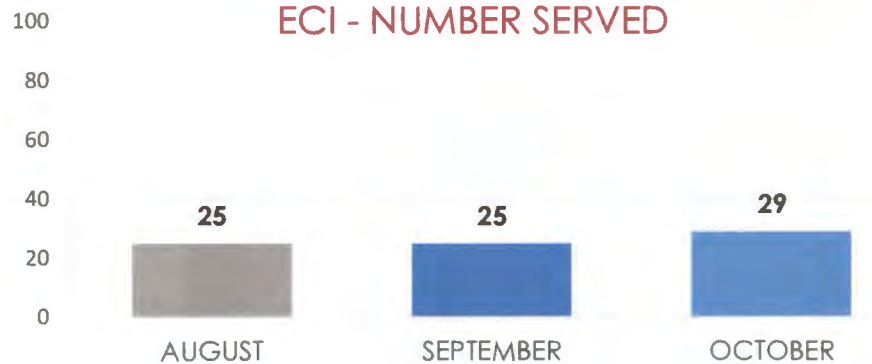
MH ADULT - NUMBER SERVED



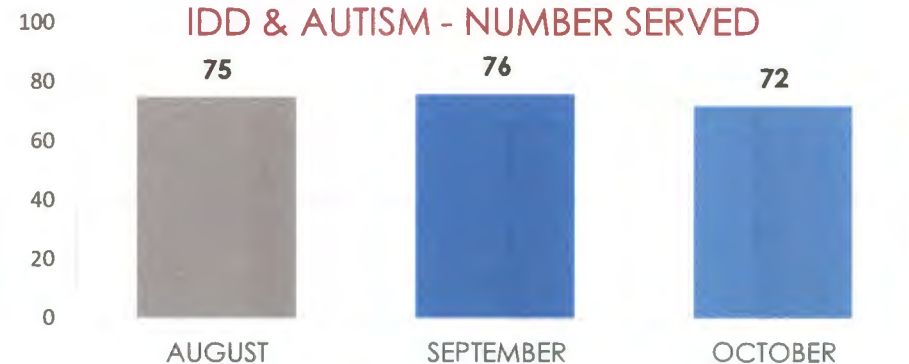
MH CHILDREN - NUMBER SERVED

IDD & AUTISM - NUMBER SERVED

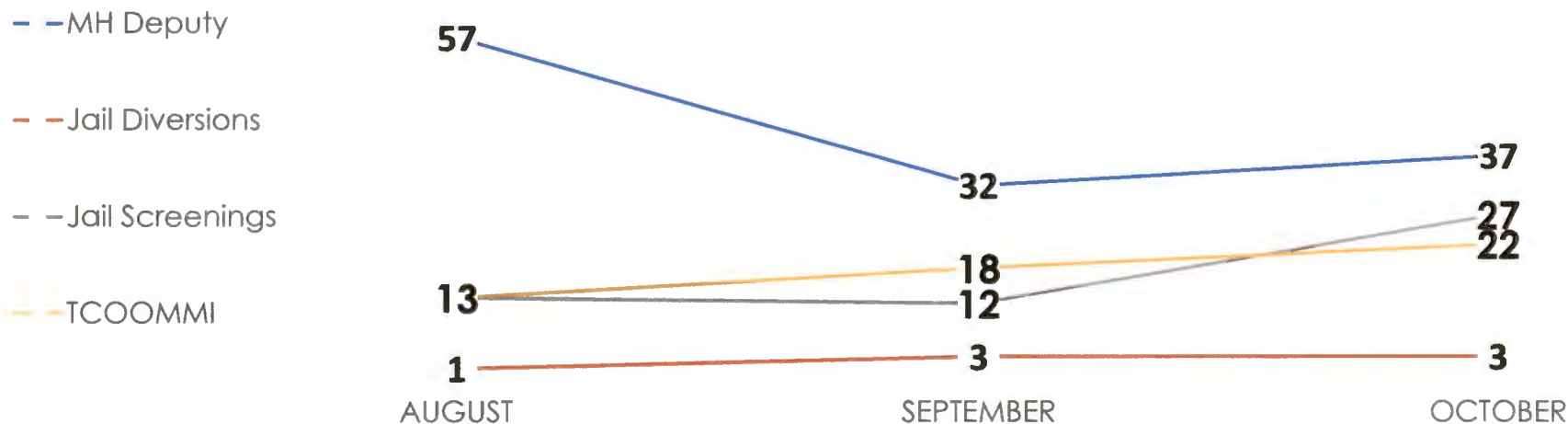


SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER - NUMBER SERVED

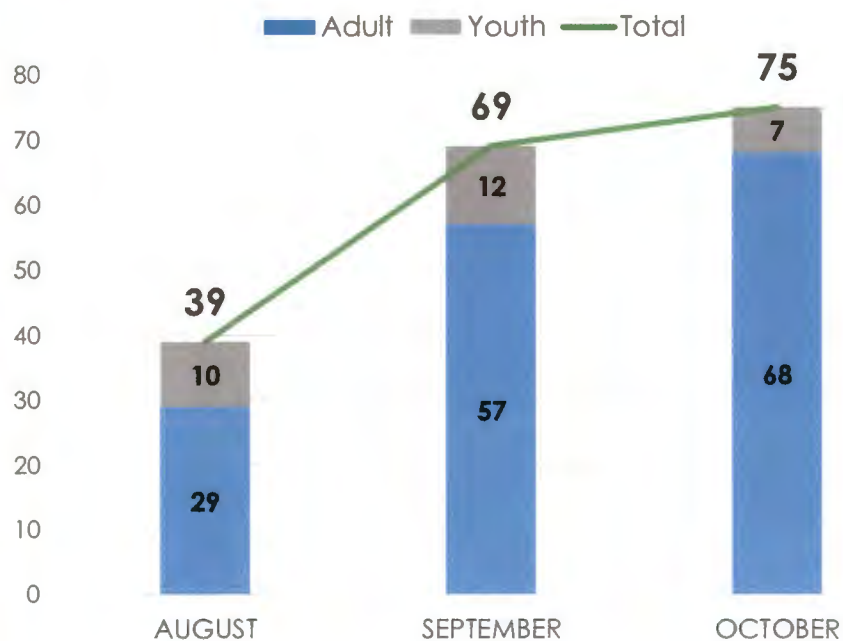
