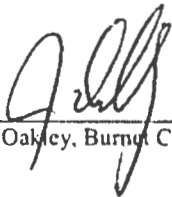
WHEREAS, Burnet County agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the FY 22 Body Worn Camera Program grant application, and

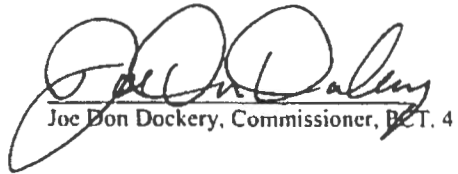

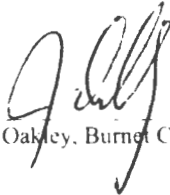

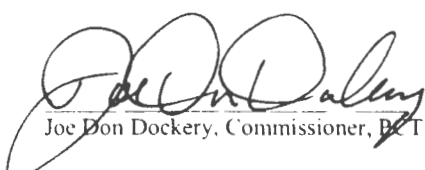
