## *Resolution of Commissioners Court*

### ARPA Funds Allocation to Standard Allowance for Revenue Loss

**WHEREAS**, Burnet County has been awarded \$9,353,544 in Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) as part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) from the Federal government for eligible COVID-19-related expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Treasury's Final Rule for ARPA Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, which was effective as of April 1, 2022, allows a Standard Allowance of up to \$10 million in aggregate for the period of performance to compensate for lost public sector revenue to fund government services; and

**WHEREAS**, local governments may use this standard allowance in lieu of calculating revenue loss using the formula prescribed in the Interim Final Rule; and

**WHEREAS**, The Commissioners Court of Burnet County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Burnet County to apply this option in order to greatly simplify and streamline reporting and grant the County the broadest flexibility in determining use of funds; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that The Commissioners Court of Burnet County hereby approves the entirety of the County's ARPA fund allocation to be utilized and reported within the "Standard Allowance" category to offset the County's lost revenue due to the pandemic, and that these funds should only be used in compliance with the U.S Treasury's Final Rule.
