First, thank you again for selecting Burnet County VETRIDE to receive \$7,692 as part of the Capital Area Housing Finance Corporation donation to Burnet County. Your continued support of the VETRIDE program means a lot, and it is very much appreciated.

We have now started our 13th year of providing transportation for our veterans and their spouses to local as well as distant appointments. Besides general primary care appointments, we have taken veterans, their spouses and widows to specialty care, wound care, eye care, cancer treatments, lab work, procedures/surgeries, return home from in-patient rehab centers after surgery and from hospitals. The three wheelchair accessible vans and home pick up have become more and more needed for our veterans. It is an honor for us to be of service to our veterans in this way.

During this TVC Grant year, we have driven 830 trips with 1020 seats filled, traveling 99,812 miles and over 4230 driver hours. Of the 194 unduplicated riders, 72 are new to VETRIDE.

Thank you again from all of us with VETRIDE and on behalf of each veteran, spouse and widow that we serve. They say thank you to us many times and we pass this thank you to you who keep VETRIDE traveling the roads for our veterans and their families.
