After hearing and considering the testimony, evidence, questions, and comments of all persons appearing at the hearing;

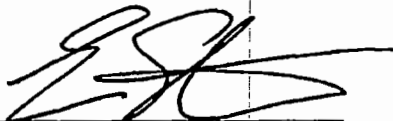
It is **ORDERED** for the fiscal year 2022-2023 that the salaries of the Auditor and Assistants, as set out in Schedule 1 attached hereto and made a part hereof as if set out in full herein, be paid in equal monthly installments and the travel expenses and other allowances, as set out therein, be paid, as incurred, from the General Fund of Burnet County, Texas.

It is further **ORDERED** that the District Clerk of Burnet County file this Order and certify same to the Commissioners' Court of said county, and that said Commissioners' Court shall cause this Order to be recorded in its minutes. Transcription of the public hearing of August 17 2022, together with all documentary and/or written evidence introduced at said hearing are ordered to be filed in the office of the District Clerk of Burnet County, Texas, and maintained as a public record as part of this Order.

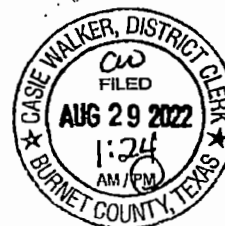

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1 (In open public forum.)

2 THE COURT: All right. So we're going
3 to go on the record. The purpose of this meeting, it's
4 a public meeting regarding several items but setting
5 the annual compensation, travel expenses, and allow
6 allowances of the county auditors and assistant
7 auditors for Burnet, Blanco, and Llano Counties, but
8 it's for the reappointment of the auditors in each of
9 those counties and reappointment of the Burnet County
10 Purchasing Agent, including setting the annual
11 compensation, and then last is setting the annual
12 compensation of the official court reporters for the
13 33rd and 424th Judicial District Courts.

14 It is a public meeting, so I guess we should
15 be on the record to say that I'm here. My name is
16 Allan Garrett, District Judge for the 33rd District and
17 then --

18 JUDGE STUBBS: Judge -- or Evan Stubbs,
19 I'm the Judge for the 424th District Court, cover those
20 four -- or, well, Burnet, Blanco, Llano, and San Saba
21 Counties as well.

22 JUDGE GARRETT: We also have my Court
23 Coordinator, Lisa Bell. We have the Burnet County
24 Judge James Oakley.

25 I don't know if she --

1 THE REPORTER: I heard you.

2 JUDGE GARRETT: Oh okay. All right.

3 And then let's see. Maybe it's best if we
4 just call it out, who's here so....

5 COMMISSIONER DOCKERY: Joe Don Dockery,
6 Burnet County, Precinct 4.

7 THE REPORTER: That's where I'm having
8 problems hearing.

9 JUDGE GARRETT: Okay.

10 JUDGE STUBBS: That was Joe Don
11 Dockery, Precinct 4 for Burnet County.

12 COMMISSIONER BEIERLE: Damon Beierle.

13 JUDGE STUBBS: And then we have David
14 Beierle who is Precinct 2 for Burnet County, and
15 then we have Karin Smith the current -- the current
16 Auditor for Burnet County.

17 JUDGE GARRETT: That's it as far as
18 from the public.

19 Let the record reflect the courthouse --
20 courtroom doors are open. It's open to the public, and
21 so let's start I guess first with the setting the
22 annual amount of compensation, travel expenses, and
23 other allowances of county auditors and assistant
24 auditors for Burnet, Blanco, and Llano Counties.

25 And I guess before we start, is there -- the

1 discussion I guess we should have is in each of these
2 counties, the changes that I've seen after reviewing
3 the proposed auditor budgets tend to come from the --
4 they're based upon what that county is doing as far as
5 salary adjustments due to inflation and cost of living
6 rises, you know, over the last -- well, I guess it's
7 been over a year now, but recognized over the last year
8 and so those adjustments have been made to each of
9 those as far as the big adjustments.

10 And then in each of these I don't have any
11 independent verification, but I have -- but I do know
12 that in each of these, the Auditor has spoken with the
13 County Judge for the county. I've spoken to the County
14 Judge of that county. I haven't spoken to each
15 individual Commissioner, and that it's been worked
16 through that County Judge's budget, and they're aware
17 of these budgets and -- and the -- and the requests by
18 each Auditor in each county.

19 I guess that's -- for a public backdrop,
20 that needs to be stated, you know, coming into this
21 meeting.

22 And Judge Stubbs?

23 JUDGE STUBBS: Any issues or questions
24 or discussion regarding the Burnet Auditor's budgets or
25 compensation? No?

1 All right. Then at this point I would make
2 the motion that we approve the Burnet County Auditor's
3 budget attached as Schedule One to the Administrative
4 Order that we're looking at, and it's my understanding
5 that that is agreeable to the County Judge and
6 Commissioners, and that it's been put into the proposed
7 budget for the County for the upcoming fiscal year, and
8 so I would move that it be approved as stated.

9 JUDGE GARRETT: And I guess we'll open
10 it back for discussion, if anything's popped up.

11 Hearing none, I guess all in favor say aye.

12 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

13 JUDGE GARRETT: Aye.

14 It passes.

15 Okay. Now, we'll move to the next in line.

16 JUDGE STUBBS: Then for the Llano
17 County compensation expenses regarding the Auditor and
18 assistant auditors for Blanco County, I would move that
19 we approve the budget as requested shown on Schedule
20 One attached to the Administrative Order that we're
21 looking at.

22 JUDGE GARRETT: All right. There's a
23 motion on the floor. Any discussion?

24 Seeing and hearing none, all in favor say
25 aye.

1 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

2 JUDGE GARRETT: Aye.

3 Opposed? Hear none.

4 JUDGE STUBBS: And then at this time I
5 would move that we approve the compensation and
6 expenses for the Auditor for Llano County as provided
7 and shown on Schedule One attached to the
8 Administrative Order that we're looking at.

9 JUDGE GARRETT: All right. Got a
10 motion. Any discussion from the public?

11 Hearing none, all in favor?

12 Aye.

13 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

14 JUDGE GARRETT: None opposed.

15 So now we'll move along to the appointment
16 of the auditors.

17 JUDGE STUBBS: Then at this point I
18 would move that we reappoint Karin Smith as the Auditor
19 for Burnet County for the upcoming two-year period and
20 would add that we couldn't be happier and thank you
21 very much for -- for being available and think you've
22 done a wonderful job. I've had nothing but positive
23 feedback from anybody that's had anything to do with
24 the auditor, and it's a pleasure and an honor to
25 hopefully reappoint you.

1 JUDGE GARRETT: Well, I think it's
2 going to happen, at least as far as I'm concerned, and
3 also thank you for being available to our new auditors
4 in the other two counties. It's really helped our
5 entire judicial district to have your wisdom shared
6 with them as they are going to be reappointed here
7 today as well. So it's really a team effort amongst
8 the counties to -- in the auditor's office.

9 JUDGE STUBBS: Just presuming that
10 we're (inaudible).

11 JUDGE GARRETT: After your comments, I
12 think so.

13 JUDGE STUBBS: Yes. Recommend them
14 all.

15 JUDGE GARRETT: Oh. Okay.

16 JUDGE STUBBS: Karin -- Karin's gold.

17 JUDGE GARRETT: All right. Well, I'll
18 entertain a motion for --

19 JUDGE STUBBS: All right. Then I -- I
20 move that we reappoint.

21 JUDGE GARRETT: All right, and any
22 discussion? Thumbs up.

23 COMMISSIONER BEIERLE: Just like to say
24 that she's done a great job (inaudible) time, and you
25 guys did a great job hiring her, and she has made the

1 processes and to (inaudible) so much easier
2 (inaudible), so she's done a great job.

3 JUDGE STUBBS: And just for the -- for
4 the record that's Commissioner Beierle.

5 THE REPORTER: And I didn't get all of
6 it at the very end.

7 JUDGE STUBBS: Well, I think you can
8 just put "star, star," you know, five stars. Something
9 like that. Nothing but positive --

10 THE REPORTER: Blah, blah, blah.

11 JUDGE STUBBS: Yes, ma'am. Pretty
12 much.

13 COMMISSIONER BEIERLE: Thumbs-up emoji.

14 JUDGE GARRETT: Just know Ms. Greenwalt
15 works with us a lot so....

16 JUDGE STUBBS: All right.

17 JUDGE GARRETT: All right. So all in
18 favor?

19 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

20 JUDGE GARRETT: Aye. None opposed.

21 Welcome back. Thank you for coming back.
22 That's probably a better way to say it.

23 JUDGE STUBBS: And at this point I
24 would make the same motion for Shelly Wenmohs to be
25 reappointed as the Blanco County Auditor. Also all

1 feedback has been completely positive that I've
2 received, and she's not present today, but personally
3 I'm very happy with her appointment, her job
4 performance previously, and look forward to her
5 continuing to be a positive asset to Blanco County.

6 JUDGE GARRETT: And I would just echo
7 everything you just said. You said it beautifully and
8 I agree a hundred percent.

9 Any discussion on the floor?

10 Hearing none, all in favor say aye.

11 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

12 JUDGE GARRETT: Aye. Zero opposed.

13 JUDGE STUBBS: At this point I would
14 make the motion that Kelly Eckhardt be appointed or I
15 guess reappointed from her partial term to a full
16 two-year term to be the Llano County Auditor, and we --
17 every -- all -- all comments that have been made so far
18 have all been positive, and we look forward to her
19 continuing to provide a good service for Llano County,
20 and we're excited to have her as well.

21 JUDGE GARRETT: And I'll echo all of
22 those comments and sentiments. I also want to add,
23 just because I had a recent conversation with the Llano
24 County Judge, he is very happy with Ms. Eckhardt in
25 that she performs her job admirably and also keeps them

1 in check as well. She appre -- he appreciates that and
2 appreciates her -- her ethic, and so he is all in
3 favor, and I know all the Commissioners echo that.

4 So any other discussion regarding that
5 motion?

6 Hearing none, all in favor say aye.

7 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

8 JUDGE GARRETT: Aye.

9 And then last is the compensation for court
10 reporters.

11 JUDGE STUBBS: I think we have the
12 Purchasing Agent.

13 JUDGE GARRETT: Oh, sorry. You're
14 right. Skipped over.

15 JUDGE STUBBS: So at this point I would
16 also make a motion that we appoint Karin Smith as the
17 Purchasing Agent for Burnet County and approve the
18 annual salary as shown on the Administrative Order, and
19 I guess that would be a reappointment, but in any event
20 that she be the Purchasing Agent for the next two years
21 and that she be compensated for those services as
22 provided in the Order, and again nothing but positive
23 things to say, and -- and so I make a motion.

24 JUDGE GARRETT: All right.

25 COUNTY JUDGE OAKLEY: I second that

1 motion.

2 JUDGE GARRETT: That was Judge James
3 Oakley, Burnet County Judge.

4 Any other discussion regarding the
5 Purchasing Agent appointment?

6 COUNTY JUDGE OAKLEY: No. I -- I would
7 say, as our county grows, especially with the -- the
8 federal funds that we're dealing with, the -- the
9 purchasing side has come volumes and lots more work
10 involved with all the intricacies of that, and I would,
11 you know -- may need to make sure the budget -- may
12 need a little bit more horsepower on some of the RFP
13 spots in that process just because there's getting to
14 be so much to do.

15 But Karin's doing a great job managing
16 everything and -- and there's just a lot more coming
17 down the chute, and I'm kind of prerecognizing that
18 next year when we're making the budget saying we may
19 need to add some horsepower for that specific purpose,
20 so....

21 JUDGE GARRETT: All right. Any --
22 thank you for that. That was Judge Oakley again for
23 the record.

24 COMMISSIONER BEIERLE: Blah, blah,
25 blah.

1 JUDGE GARRETT: And then the Charlie
2 Brown "blah blah blah" was -- Charlie Brown's teacher.

3 Well, I will -- I guess the motion's been
4 seconded, so all in favor say aye.

5 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

6 COUNTY JUDGE OAKLEY: Aye.

7 JUDGE GARRETT: Aye.

8 All three say aye. None opposed.

9 Okay. Now, we'll move to --

10 JUDGE STUBBS: And then at this point I
11 would also make a motion that we approve the annual
12 compensation for the official court reporters for the
13 424th -- or I'm sorry, 33rd and 424th District
14 Courts -- oh, thanks -- and the hiring and setting of
15 hourly compensation for additional deputy court
16 reporters as necessary to meet the Court's schedule as
17 shown on the Administrative Order that we've been
18 looking at, and that would cover Blanco, Burnet, Llano,
19 and San Saba Counties and their proportionate share of
20 compensation for those amounts.

21 COUNTY JUDGE OAKLEY: Good motion.

22 JUDGE GARRETT: Yeah. Good motion.

23 Any discussion? And I'll just say that part
24 of this is a result -- the changes that are in there
25 are a result of a survey done by the District Judges

1 and adjusting those salaries after realizing similarly
2 situated counties were much more competitive than
3 our -- our counties, and so to get that -- and having
4 just hired one for my court, I can say without a doubt
5 that it would have been impossible to hire a court
6 reporter without making this adjustment. We would have
7 not had -- we would have had zero candidates at the
8 salary base that was originally put into place.

9 So any other discussion I guess that's out
10 there?

11 Hearing none, all in favor say aye.

12 JUDGE STUBBS: Aye.

13 JUDGE GARRETT: Aye.

14 Anything else for the record?

15 JUDGE STUBBS: I guess just that all
16 motions passed.

17 JUDGE GARRETT: All the motions passed.

18 JUDGE STUBBS: Unanimous.
