

ORDER OF THE BURNET COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING PILOT PROGRAM

Whereas the Burnet County public requires that an appropriate number of Sheriff Deputies be on duty at all times to ensure safety.

Whereas the Burnet County Sheriff Office is currently experiencing staffing issues in hiring properly accredited persons for Deputy positions.

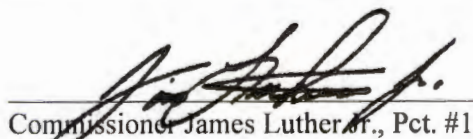
Whereas the Burnet County Sheriff Office desires to create a program that encourages individuals to invest their time into obtaining appropriate credentials by attending a TECOLE qualified law enforcement academy in order that they may serve as a Burnet Sheriff Deputy. Such a program would involve the payment of the individual's training costs by Burnet County and a commitment by the individual to serve as a Burnet County Sheriff Deputy for a period of years as re-payment of the training costs.

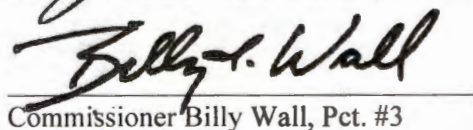
Whereas the Burnet County Commissioners wishes to support the Burnet County Sheriff's Office and wishes to start a pilot project with one individual in order to further assess the viability of a full program that encourages individuals to become Burnet County Sheriffs Deputies.

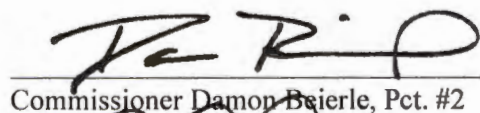
Therefore, the Burnet County Commissioners Court finds that the use of public funds for a pilot project involving one individual serves a public purpose and therefore Orders the creation of said project so that further assessment may be made for the future. The Court hereby authorizes the Burnet County Sheriff to select and contract with one individual to attend a TECOLE qualified law enforcement academy. Burnet County shall pay for the individual's the training expenses and said individual shall commit to serving as a Burnet County Sheriff Deputy for a minimum of three years in order to fully re-pay Burnet County for the training expenses. Should the individual fail to obtain the necessary law enforcement credentials and/or fail to serve as a Burnet County Sheriff Deputy for three years, then said individual shall monetarily repay Burnet County on a pro rata basis.

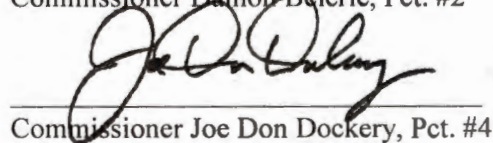

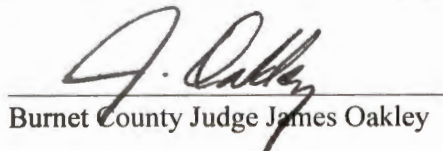
