RE: Election Integrity

Dear Judge Oakley, Commissioners Luther, Beierle, Wall & Dockery, and Mr. Ferguson,

This letter is from Burnet County resident Claire Nybro. I write this letter in a good faith effort to determine your collective resolve to strengthen election integrity in Burnet County.

1. Will the County commit to removing ineligible voter registrations if proven ineligible?
2. Will the County provide transparency, such as offering voter rolls for free or for a nominal cost, to ensure fraudulent registrations do not re-appear?
3. Is the County willing to dump the entire voter registration roll and require eligible voters to show up in person at the registrar's office to re-register with an ID?
4. Will the County commit to removing electronic voting equipment if such voting equipment can be proven to be unreliable?
5. Will the County commit to using only paper ballots counted by hand?
6. If unwilling to abandon electronic voting equipment, is the County willing to manually count ballots generated by the machines? This is critical for ensuring that total ballots match the number of voters checked in to vote and on machine logs/tapes.
7. Burnet County is outside of the top 10% of the largest population counties in the State of Texas. Will the County be willing to hold back its vote totals until the counties in the top 10% (i.e., Harris County, Dallas County, Tarrant County, Bexar County, Travis County, etc.) fully report their vote totals?
8. Does the County have a plan to address the chain of custody issues with mail-in ballots? If so, what is the plan?

As an aside, I have a suggestion that will take care of Sheriff Boyd's overtime: ditch any plan for new voting machines & give him the money you would have spent on them. Win-win for everyone!

Thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation. I look forward to a response to Questions 1 - 8 in writing.
