

Hello Commissioners,

Last week, I had the opportunity to speak with Kelly Dix about City-related library needs and she mentioned a workshop and suggested I present my requests there. However, she has since learned that any requests need to have official approval of the Court before a request is made to the City (please see email below). Here are my requests:

- **Change the City book contribution to programs**
 - The cover letter for FY22 states the funding is for programing, but the contract states that it's for books (attached for your convenience).
- **Request an increase in the contribution from \$2,000.00 to \$5,000.00**
 - The City would be our "banner sponsor" for our programs. This request is in addition to the utility credits for the year.
- **Install handicap parking directly in front of the library.**
 - The current parking is too far from the entrance and on a slope, making this difficult and tiring for our elderly patrons. Many will struggle to step up over the curb in front of the door rather than "hike" from the handicap parking. This is something our patrons frequently ask for (actually, complain about).
- **Install a two-sided ramp in the sidewalk in front of our meeting room door for handicap access.**
- **Request the repaving of the asphalt behind the library.**
 - My understanding is the paved area behind the library belongs to the City. This is were we park and receive deliveries. The asphalt is VERY uneven and in need of repaving.
