

Amendment 1 to Capital Area Council of Governments Contract for Implementation of Solid Waste Management Activities

The Capital Area Council of Governments ("CAPCOG") entered into an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Burnet County on 9/12/2022 to provide funding for household hazardous waste collection as part of CAPCOG's fiscal year (FY) 2022-2023 solid waste grant program. This agreement was numbered 23-12-01, and provided for \$35,000.00 for the project. CAPCOG and Burnet County are hereby amending this contract to bring CAPCOG's share of the final project cost up to 80%.

AMENDMENT

Total Project Cost, Award, and Match are amended as follows:

Award ~~No more than \$35,000 or 40.79% of the project's financial cost, whichever is less~~
\$33,865.12

Required Match ~~\$50,795.00 or 59.21% of the actual cost if less than \$85,795~~ \$8,466.28

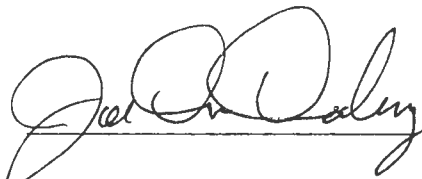
Section 1.02(b) is amended as follows:

The SUBRECIPIENT agrees to implement the Project ~~according to the agreed upon budget in an amount no more than \$35,000.00 or 40.79% of the project's financial cost, whichever is less as detailed in Article VII of this Contract~~ using no more than \$33,865.12 in grant funding.
