

Court Order # 39953

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING TEXAS STATE LEGISLATION FOR ACCURATE, TRANSPARENT, AUDITABLE ELECTIONS

Whereas, WE THE PEOPLE OF KERR COUNTY, TEXAS need to be certain that all Texans and Americans have SECURE, ACCURATE, TRANSPARENT, and AUDITABLE elections with full ACCOUNTABILITY for those who violate our election laws;

Whereas, the current electronic voting system, that is approved for use, may create an unnecessary security risk with opportunities for undetectable error and nefarious activities;

Whereas, our voter rolls may be inaccurate and emphasis must be placed to insure accuracy;

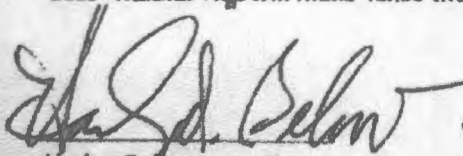
Whereas, maintaining three separate voting processes of mail-in, early, and election day voting creates risks and opportunities for abuse, error and broken chains of custody;

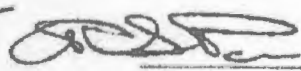
Whereas, it may be uncertain for the electorate to know whether the declared winner reflects the intent of the majority of the people who legally cast their vote in the race and recent polls show that a large percentage of the population across party lines has lost faith in our elections;

Be it resolved, that the Kerr County Commissioners Court formally requests the 88th Texas Legislature pass legislation to minimize election mismanagement and vote manipulation by requiring:

- hand-marked, sequentially numbered paper ballots preprinted on counterfeit-resistant paper, signed by an election judge,
- paper poll books, fixed 30 days before the election period,
- verifying vote results with random hand counts and robust audits,
- elimination of the gap between election day and the end of early voting,
- limiting mail-in voting to only those who legitimately need it,
- cleaning and securing our voter rolls ensuring they contain only qualified and eligible citizens,
- eliminating the costly and ineffective ERIC system (Electronic Registration Information Center),
- restoration of felony penalties for fraudulent voting,
- reinstatement of Texas Attorney General's prosecutorial authority to investigate and prosecute, election and voter fraud,
- prohibition of rank choice voting and any foreign ownership of election processes, data storage, or components,
- county-to-precinct and state-to-county election results verification,

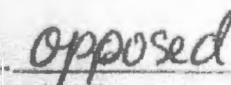
Which will result in an election process that is transparent, accurate, verifiable, and holds officials and voters accountable. This will make Texas the nation's leader in election integrity.
