Dear Governor,

The County of Burnet, Texas is facing significant threats to life, health, and property due to persistent extreme drought conditions

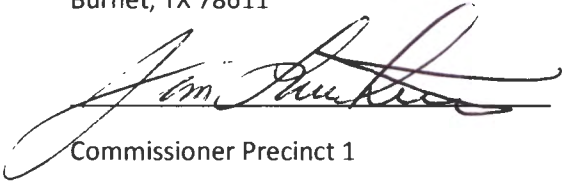
The impacts of this threat range from water scarcity for human consumption and agricultural uses, damage to various infrastructure, and more.

I have determined that the threat of drought is of such severity and magnitude that an effective response would be beyond the capability of the local jurisdiction to control. Pursuant to §418.108 of the Texas Government Code, I am requesting that you keep Burnet County attached to the state of emergency for the State of Texas regarding drought and fire conditions and issue appropriate directives and requests to deal with the emergency.

Furthermore, I am asking that successive proclamations be issued and remain in effect until the threat of loss of life, injury, or damage to property is contained.

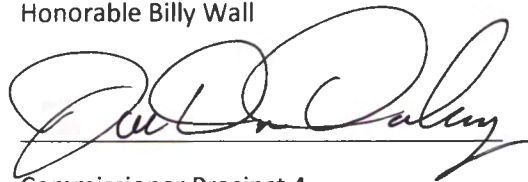
