Dear Governor,

The County of Burnet, Texas is facing significant threats to life, health, and property due to threat of wildland fires.

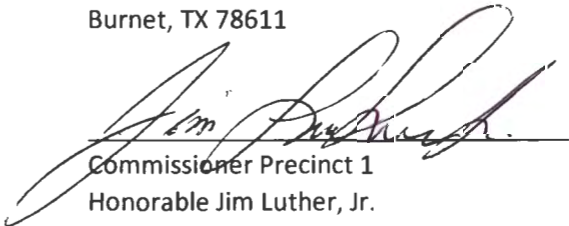
The impact of this threat is: damage to energy infrastructure, water and sewer infrastructure, transportation infrastructure, communications infrastructure, homes, businesses, and life safety. Due to the current levels of fuel dryness, available energy for fires, and fire danger forecasts that the threat to life and property has increased.

I have determined that the threat of wildland fire is of such severity and magnitude that an effective response would be beyond the capability of the local jurisdiction to control. Pursuant to §418.108 of the Texas Government Code, I am requesting that you keep Burnet County attached to the state of emergency for the State of Texas regarding drought and fire conditions and issue appropriate directives and requests to deal with the emergency.

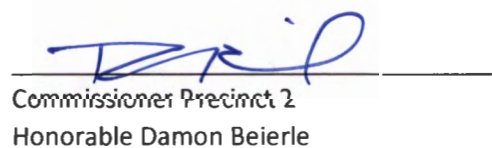
Furthermore, I am asking that successive proclamations be issued and remain in effect until the threat of loss of life, injury, or damage to property is contained.

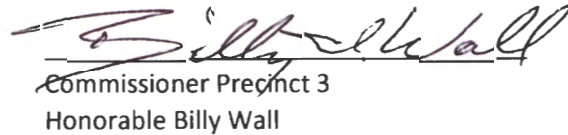

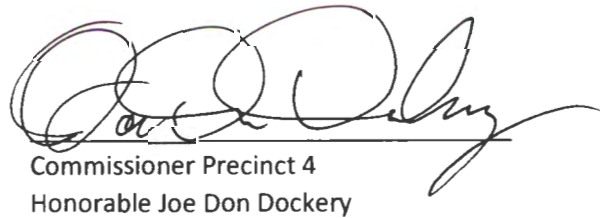
