WHEREAS, the Hart Verity Ballot on Demand 2.7 voting system by Hart Intercivic is comprised of the Verity Print, Verity Touch Writer ADA device, Verity Scan, and the Verity Data, Build, Central and Count Software, and

WHEREAS, Section 123.035 of the Texas Election Code requires that use of new voting equipment must be approved by the Elections Division of the office of the Texas Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, the County has received approval from the State of Texas for purchase of the Hart Ballot on Demand voting system that is certified for use in Texas, and

WHEREAS, the Burnet County Elections Department, acting by and through the Burnet County Commissioners Court, has purchased the new ADA-compliant Hart Ballot on Demand 2.7 voting system to be used for early and regular election day voting by Burnet County for the November 4th, 2025 election and all subsequent elections; and

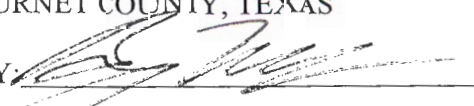
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 123.001 (b) of the Texas Election Code, Burnet County must formally adopt said voting system;
