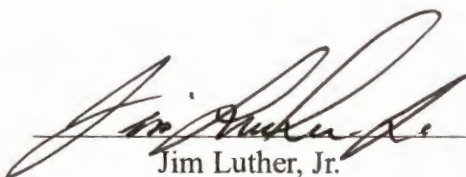
WHEREAS: Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week,

NOW, THEREFORE We, the Burnet County commissioners court, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as

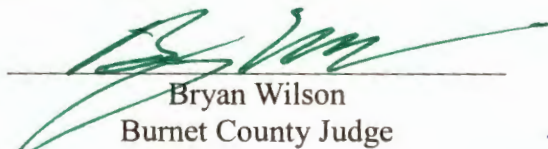
CONSTITUTION WEEK

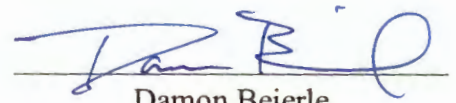

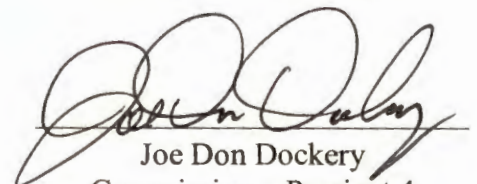
