

Order Authorizing Burnet County's Participation in a County Health Care Provider Participation Program, Collection of a Mandatory Payment, and Use of Funds from Mandatory Payments

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature enacted Chapter 300 to the Health and Safety Code and which went into effect June 10, 2019;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 300.0004 of the Health and Safety Code, the Commissioners Court of a county may by order authorize the county to participate in a county health care provider participation program;

WHEREAS, the purpose of participation in a county health care provider participation program is to generate revenue from a mandatory payment that may be required by the county from an institutional health care provider to fund certain intergovernmental transfers;

WHEREAS, pursuant to new Section 300.0004 of the Health and Safety Code, the Commissioners Court of a county that participates in a county health care provider participation program may, by an affirmative vote of the majority of the members of the Commissioners Court authorize the county to collect a mandatory payment from each institutional health care provider located in the county; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 300.0103, a county that participates in a county health care provider participation program may use the funds collected through mandatory payments only for specified purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Commissioners Court of Burnet County authorizes Burnet County to:

1. Participate in a county health care provider participation program;
2. Collect a mandatory payment from each institutional health care provider located in the County; and
3. Use the funds collected through mandatory payments for the purposes specified in Section 300.0103.
