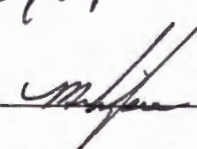

Beyond training, this summit creates something the public safety aviation community has long needed: a true network of operators working together to advance the future of public safety aviation.

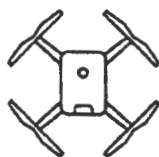
