**ORDER DETERMINING THE AMOUNT AND SUFFICIENCY OF THE
TREASURER'S BOND FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICTS LOCATED IN
BURNET COUNTY**

The Texas Health and Safety Code §775.037(b) requires the Treasurer of each Emergency Services District to execute and file with the county clerk a bond conditioned on the faithful execution of the treasurer's duties; and further provides that the County Judge of the county in which the bond is to be filed must determine the amount and sufficiency of the bond before it is filed.

There are multiple Emergency Services Districts located wholly or partly within Burnet County, Texas, whose treasurers are required to file their bonds with the Burnet County Clerk pursuant to §775.037(b) of the Texas Health and Safety Code.

Having reviewed and considered the financial activities, revenues, and responsibilities of the Emergency Services Districts located within Burnet County, and hereby find that a bond in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is appropriate to adequately protect the public interest and ensure the faithful performance of the duties of such treasurers.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Treasurer of each Emergency Services District located wholly or partly within Burnet County, Texas, shall obtain, execute, and file with the Burnet County Clerk a surety bond in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), conditioned on the faithful execution of the treasurer's duties, as required by Texas Health and Safety Code §775.037(b). Such bond shall be maintained in full force and effect at all times during the treasurer's term of office.

It is further ORDERED that the bond shall be executed by a corporate surety authorized to do business in the State of Texas and shall be in a form satisfactory to the Burnet County Clerk. Prior to filing, the bond shall be presented to the County Judge for a determination of its sufficiency as required by §775.037(b).

Upon approval of the bond's sufficiency by the County Judge, the Treasurer of each affected Emergency Services District shall promptly file the bond with the Burnet County Clerk. In the event a new Treasurer is elected or appointed, such Treasurer shall obtain, execute, and file a bond meeting the requirements of this ORDER before assuming the duties of the office.

In the event any bond filed pursuant to this ORDER lapses, is cancelled, or is otherwise terminated, the Treasurer shall immediately obtain and file a replacement bond meeting the requirements of this ORDER. No Treasurer shall continue to exercise the duties of the office while serving without a bond in full force and effect.

The Burnet County Clerk is hereby ORDERED to provide a certified copy of this ORDER to the presiding officer of the board of each Emergency Services District located wholly or partly within Burnet County, Texas.
