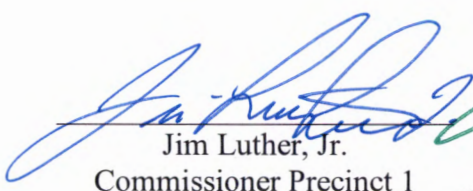

WHEREAS, it is fitting for the people of Burnet County to come together in gratitude for our community, our history, and the blessings enjoyed by our citizens;

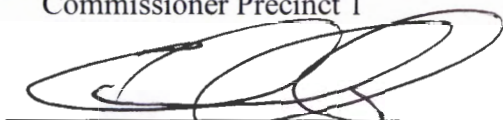
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners Court of Burnet County, Texas, that:

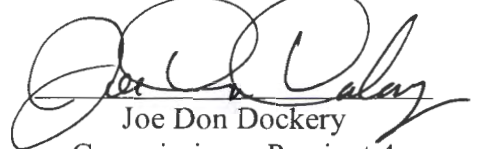
