



A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS, REMEMBERING THE VICTIMS OF THE JULY 5, 2025, FLOODS; RECOGNIZING THE INDIVIDUALS, VOLUNTEERS, FIRST RESPONDERS, NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, BUSINESSES, AND GOVERNMENTAL PARTNERS WHO ASSISTED IN THE RESPONSE AND RECOVERY EFFORTS; AND DIRECTING THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF APPRECIATION TO BUSINESSES THAT DONATED TIME, SERVICES, AND MATERIALS TO ASSIST THE CITIZENS OF BURNET COUNTY.

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2025, Burnet County experienced devastating flooding that resulted in tragic loss of life, personal hardship, and significant damage to homes, businesses, infrastructure, and public property; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court pauses to honor and remember the lives of those who perished, extends its deepest condolences to their families and loved ones, and recognizes the resilience and strength demonstrated by the residents of Burnet County during this difficult time; and

WHEREAS, the response to this disaster reflected the extraordinary commitment of first responders, law enforcement agencies, firefighters, emergency medical personnel, emergency management officials, public works employees, volunteer organizations, nonprofit agencies, faith-based organizations, neighboring jurisdictions, state and federal partners, and countless volunteers who worked tirelessly to protect lives, provide aid, and assist in recovery efforts; and

WHEREAS, numerous local and regional businesses generously donated equipment, labor, professional services, supplies, food, building materials, and other resources that were essential in supporting emergency operations and helping Burnet County residents begin the recovery process; and

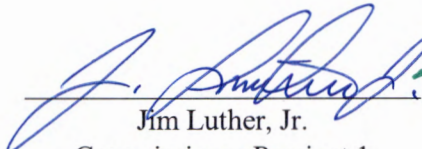

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners Court of Burnet County, Texas, that:

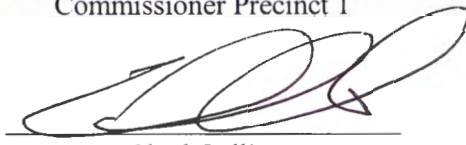
