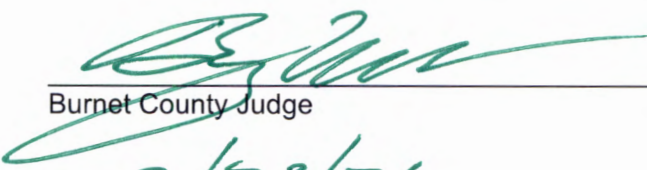


Title VI/Nondiscrimination Policy Statement

Burnet County hereby gives public notice of its policy to uphold and assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. §2000d et seq., and all related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which Burnet County receives federal financial assistance. Burnet County further assures that every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability in all of its programs and activities, whether or not those programs or activities are federally funded, consistent with the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with Burnet County's Title VI Coordinator. A complainant may also file a complaint directly with the TxDOT Civil Rights Division or the Federal Highway Administration.
