

**ORDER OF THE BURNET COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
APPROVING INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF
BURNET FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO SHADY GROVE PARKWAY**

On this the 25 day of August, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Burnet County, Texas, convened in regular session with a quorum present and considered the following matter:

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code authorizes local governments to enter into interlocal agreements for the performance of governmental functions and services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Burnet and Burnet County desire to cooperate in the completion of roadway improvements consisting of paving approximately 1,500 linear feet of Shady Grove Parkway from its intersection with Shady Grove Road to its intersection with Colby Canyon; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that the project will promote and improve public safety and serve a valid public purpose as it will improve roadway conditions, facilitate emergency services access; and

WHEREAS, the total value of Burnet County's contributions to the project, including manpower, equipment, and associated labor-related expenses, shall not exceed \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has reviewed the proposed Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Burnet County and the City of Burnet and finds that approval of the Agreement is in the best interests of the citizens of Burnet County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

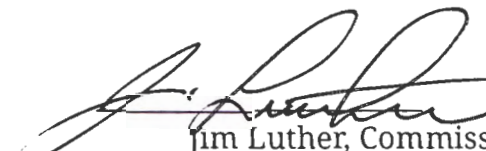
1. The Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Burnet County, Texas and the City of Burnet, Texas concerning roadway improvements to Shady Grove Parkway is hereby approved.
2. The County Judge is authorized to execute the Agreement and any non-substantive documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Order.
3. County personnel are authorized to provide labor, equipment, supervision, and associated resources necessary to perform the County's obligations under the Agreement, provided that the total value shall not exceed \$15,000.
4. The Commissioners Court specifically finds that the County's participation in the project serves a valid county purpose.

This Order shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

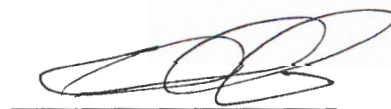

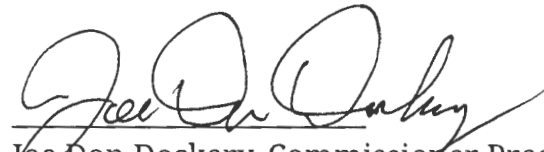

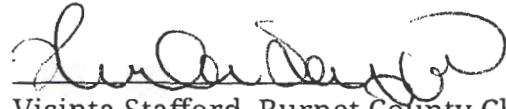
