REQUEST 1. *PLEASE PROVIDE REPUTABLE RESEARCH AND CLINICAL STUDIES establishing the safety of the 765KV Transmission line emissions.*

Q1: Have any medical studies been performed on the health and safety effects of the 765KV Transmission line emissions? Lab studies? Clinical studies? Field studies? Please advise.

Q2: What is the effect of the emission from the 765KV Transmission line on the general health of residents and drivers of vehicles traveling on CR 108?

Q3: What are the health effects and concerns of continuous and repeated exposure to 765KV emissions to travelers. Note; the i1 segment appears to run closely parallel to CR 108 for miles.

- A. Using Pacemakers and other electronic devices
- B. Healthy adults and children
- C. Elderly
- D. Pregnant women
- E. Unborn babies; zygote > embryo > fetus
- F. People with various health challenges such as dialysis, heart ailments, diabetes, pacemakers, pain control, medical implants, etc.

Q4: What are the health effects of continuous and repeated exposure to 765KV emissions to wild and domesticated animals and insects such as deer, horses, bees, dogs, etc?

Q5: What are the health effects of continuous and repeated exposure to 765KV emissions from downed lines?

REQUEST 2. *PLEASE DEVELOP AND PUBLISH A PLAN FOR AN EMERGENCY QUICK-RESPONSE EVACUATION OF THE RESIDENTS OF BLACK BUCK RIDGE, ANTLER LANE, RIFLE RIDGE, AND OTHERS LOCATED ALONG THE I1 765KV SEGMENT, ASSUMING A WORST-CASE SCENARIO.*

- Downed 765KV Transmission lines impeding/preventing ingress and egress.
- Downed 765KV Transmission lines exposing residents and responders to continuous high levels of emissions.
- Multiple emergencies requiring ambulances, fire equipment, and skilled responders.
- Need for immediate evacuation due to threats to life and safety.
 - A. Ambulance, county sheriff/deputies, fire department, and other responders unable to safely traverse the downed 765KV Transmission line.
 - B. Necessary evacuation of a substantial number of the residents imperiled by the downing of the 765KV Transmission line(s), laying across CR 108 and/or CR 109, preventing ingress and egress by residents and emergency responders.
