

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANYON LAKE, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES CURRENTLY PROVIDED BY THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND TO BE ASSUMED BY THE CANYON LAKE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE FUTURE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Canyon Lake ("City") is authorized to impose fees to recover the reasonable costs of services it provides pursuant to its police power under Article XI, Section 7 of the California Constitution and applicable law; and

**WHEREAS**, the City currently contracts with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department ("Sheriff's Department") for the provision of law enforcement services within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has established a municipal police department, which has not yet commenced operations and is anticipated to assume responsibility for providing law enforcement services within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Department presently maintains a fee schedule for various law enforcement-related services, which is intended to reflect the costs incurred to provide such services, and has calculated such fees using billing rates designed to achieve full cost recovery, except where fees are set by State law; and

**WHEREAS**, the City seeks to establish a fee schedule for law enforcement services presently provided by the Sheriff's Department and scheduled to be assumed by the Canyon Lake Police Department in the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed fees are intended to recover no more than the reasonable costs of providing the services for which the fees are charged; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council further finds that the fees established by this Resolution will not exceed the fees currently established by the Sheriff's Department for the same or similar services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City intends for the fee schedule established by this Resolution to serve as an interim measure pending completion of a Citywide comprehensive fee study, including for law enforcement-related services to further evaluate and refine such fees, anticipated by December 31, 2030; and

**WHEREAS**, a duly noticed public hearing was held prior to adoption of this Resolution, at which time all interested persons were given the opportunity to be heard and present evidence.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANYON LAKE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 2.** The City Council hereby adopts the fee schedule set forth in Exhibit “A,” attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 3.** The provisions of this Resolution are severable and if any provision, clause, sentence, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstances, such illegality, invalidity, unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, sections, words or parts thereof of the Resolution or their applicability to other persons or circumstances.

**Section 4.** That the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and that the same shall be in full force and effect.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
