

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANYON LAKE, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH PNC EQUIPMENT FINANCE, LLC, FOR A NEW TYPE I FIRE ENGINE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,176,148.24

WHEREAS, the City of Canyon Lake is a political subdivision of the State in which Municipality is located (the “State”) and is duly organized and existing pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State. and

WHEREAS, South Coast Fire Equipment is a local vendor for Pierce Manufacturing which provides fire engines for the Cities of Murrieta, Riverside, Palm Springs, Cathedral City; and

WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) conducted a competitive bid process and has obtained competitive pricing for such vehicles and participating members; and

WHEREAS, THE City is authorized under the Canyon Lake Municipal Code section 3.08.360 to award contracts for materials, supplies, equipment or services; and

WHEREAS, the lease/purchase agreement will commence in August, 2027; and

WHEREAS, PNC Bank, National Association (“Lessor”) shall act as Lessor under said Leases.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANYON LAKE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or their designee, enter into a lease/purchase agreement for (1) Type I structural fire engine from PNC Equipment Finance through H-GAC for a purchase cost of \$1,176,148.24.

Section 3. The provisions of this Resolution are severable and if any provision, clause, sentence, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstances, such illegality, invalidity, unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, sections, words or parts thereof of the Resolution or their applicability to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and that the same shall be in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
