Overview of Child Crisis Arizona programs - known basically as an emergency children's shelter serving children under 10 who have been removed from their home by social services. But there is also a group home for boys ages 11-17, and now have an independent living program for children ages 16-20. There are also a lot of other programs that wrap around creating stronger and more successful families. Our Counseling and Early Education Programs serve families that are 100-200% under the federal poverty level. We find a lot of families struggling with domestic violence and may not have re-sources. The FANS program is a resource center for basic necessities, done by referral from all different resources.
