Possibly put disclosure on the invite saying that the speaker not necessarily shares the views of the DV Commission. Katie Cain will bring total number of people attending the event to the next meeting. EventBrite does not send prior invites, we may want to consider a different type of invite for next year.
3. Community Outreach Subcommittee – Chandler Unified School District staff were very receptive and would also like us at the middle schools. They are open to having us throughout the year, not just the month of February to talk about healthy relationships. We will be talking to social workers and art teachers. Possibly do healthy relationships/art to partnership with Field of Hope. We may need to decide what we will do with tables at the schools. The wheel, treasure box and candy seemed to be a draw for those age groups. We may have a November sign up sheet for Jan-May school events.
