Background/Discussion

Each year, council provides \$30K for special events done in the community put on by nonprofit organizations. The Special Events Division oversees the panel that reviews the applications and allocates funding to these nonprofits. The panel has always had a representative from the Mayor's Youth Commission, and is looking for a representative to serve again this year.

The nominated individual would need to attend the panel meeting on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, from 5-8 p.m. The meeting takes place at City Hall – 2nd Floor Training Room and dinner is provided. This would not serve as an additional opportunity for Mayors Youth Commission participation, but would instead replace a meeting attendance requirement as it takes place during the same place and time as regularly scheduled youth commission meetings.
