2. ACTION AGENDA

Ideas that may be incorporated into the City of Chandler's memorial wall include the process to select candidates for the wall, and the pricing strategy. Mr. Mickey Ohland, Community Services Planning Senior Manager, discussed an option for the material to be used when building the wall/name plaques.


