a. Update - Discussion on hosting a Service Recognition Event recognizing high school students who have committed to military service after graduation.

Commissioner Waltzer updated the **Commission** on the food that will be provided for the event on May 9, 2023. The following venders will be used: West Valley Barbeque, Ghett' Yo Tacos, Mingle and Graze, and Pie Snob. Sandy Popovich will pay the food service invoices using the one-time funding from the City. Costs will be approximately \$3,500 - \$4,000.

Commissioner Levinson updated the **Commission** on his discussion with Sergeant Ortega regarding the RSVP's to the event. Approximately thirty enlisted will attend. The Air Force, Army, Navy, and Marine Corp will be represented by the newly enlisted. The schedule for the National Anthem, the Pledge of Allegiance, and the Presentation of Colors is being coordinated. Mayor Hartke is expected to be the Master of Ceremony and Vice Mayor Orlando will be the Key Note Speaker.
