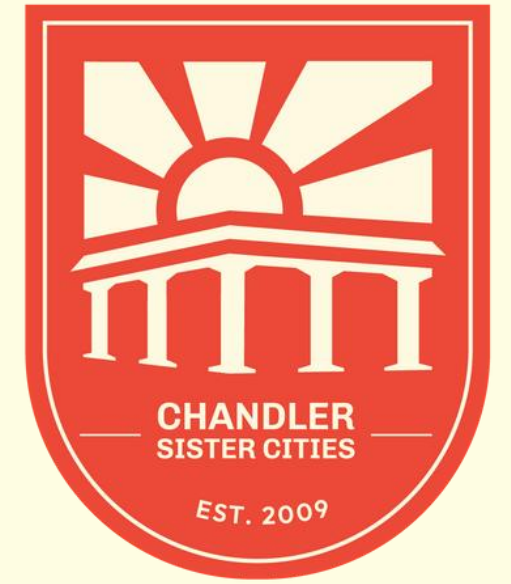

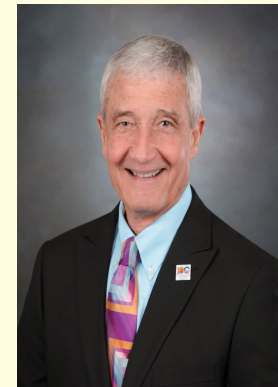

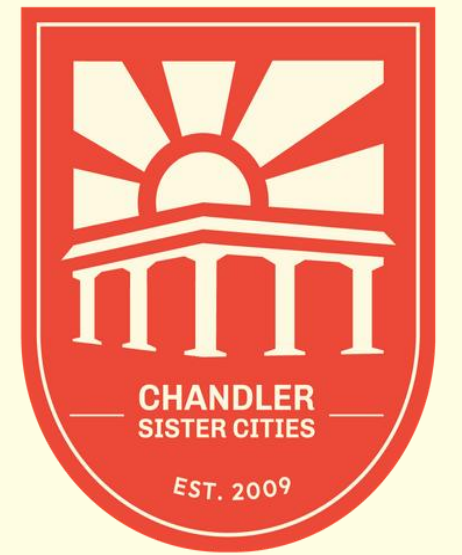

- Art and Culture: Celebrate the diversity of arts, culture, and stories.

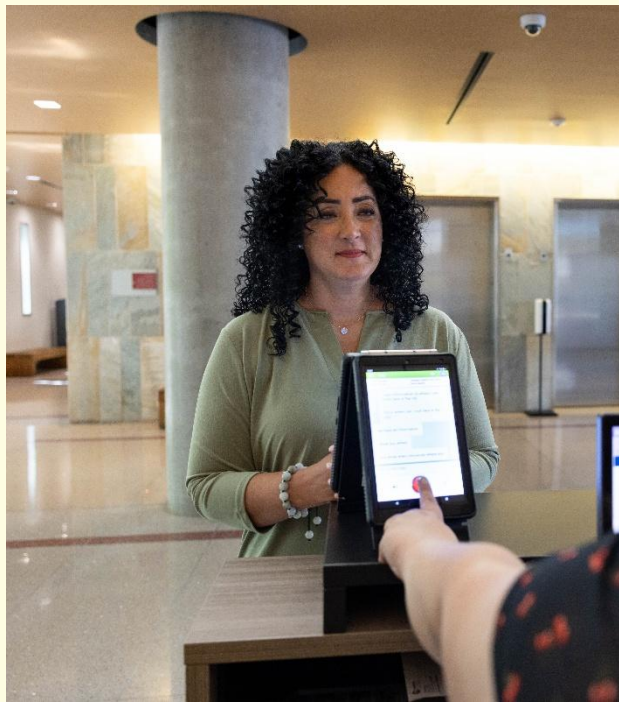

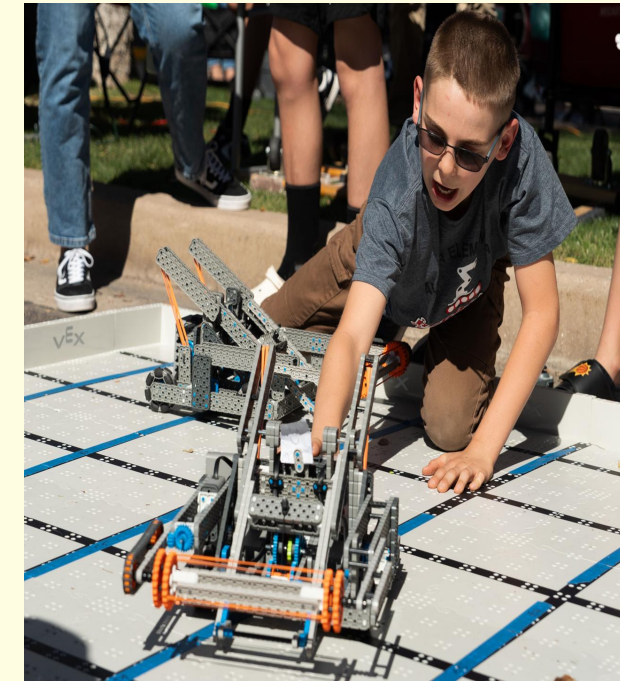

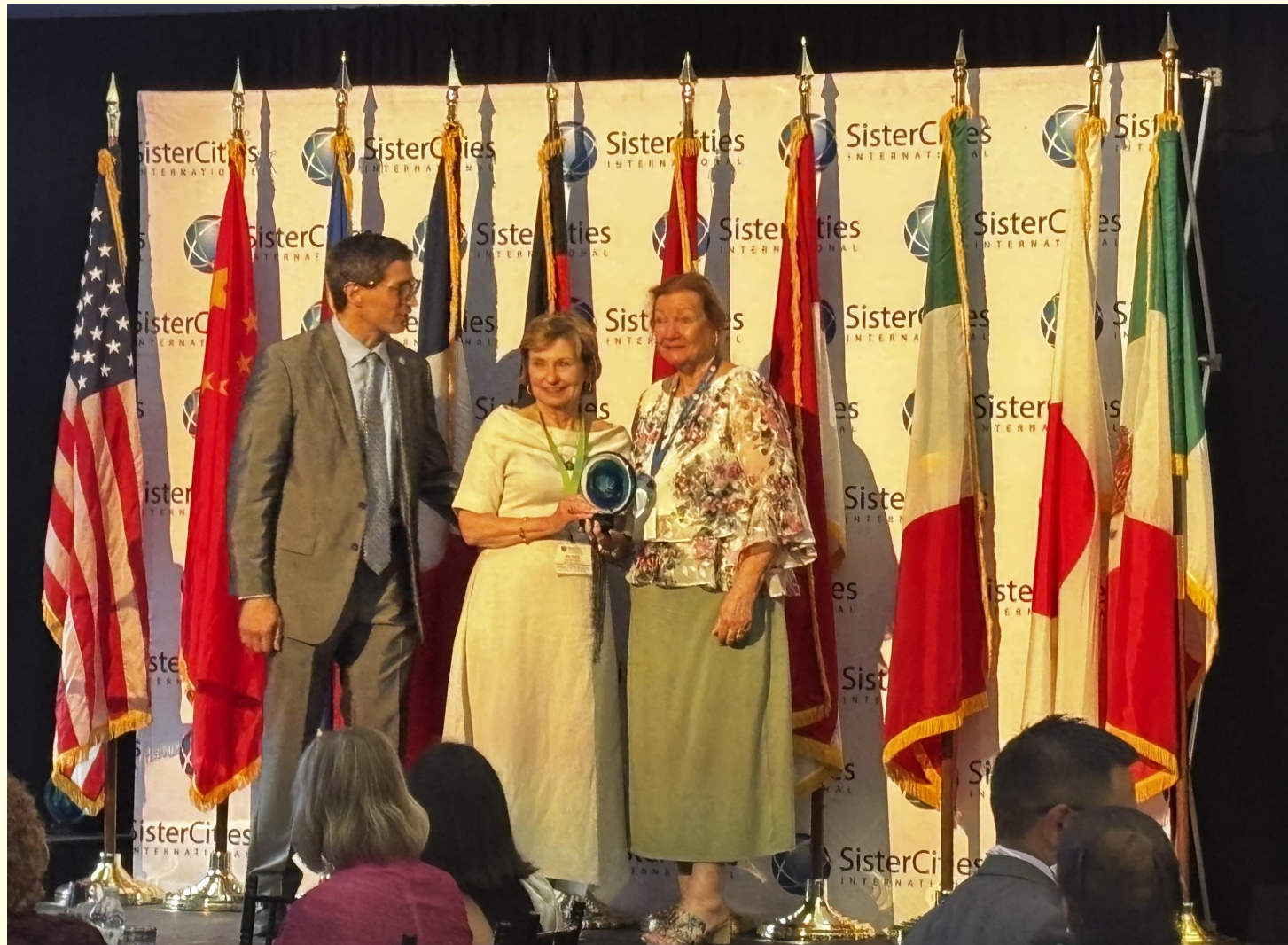
