Student: Courage to learn and grow; achieves personal goals despite disability (ages 3–22).

Educator: Hands-on education or habilitation with positive impact.

Volunteer: Significant time, active service, positive outcomes.

Disability Ally: Advocacy, inclusion, active engagement, impact.

Employee: Employee with a disability; performs at or above expectations.

Employer: Inclusive hiring, accommodations, accessible workplace.
