Agreement Terms

- Intergovernmental Agreement established in June 2025 for 5 years.
- This is the first annual amendment and corresponds to the FY2026-27.
- The amendment will run through June 30, 2027.
- Local funding amount for fixed route, paratransit, and RideChoice is \$1,259,766.

- Federal Grants
