WHEREAS, every resident of Cochise County deserves enough to eat;

WHEREAS, in the current economic downturn, local food banks and shelters are struggling to meet the needs of families and children;

WHEREAS, the national Federal Emergency Management Agency’s Emergency Food & Shelter Program is experiencing funding cutbacks, resulting in less money being directed to the Local Board and through it, to the Local Recipient Organizations (food pantries and shelters);

WHEREAS, the amount of funding for the current year through the Emergency Food & Shelter Program (EFSP) has not yet been announced and no funds have been released, to-date;

WHEREAS, the tragic events in Tucson on January 8, 2011 spawned a groundswell of volunteerism;

WHEREAS, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors at their regular meeting on January 25, 2011 offered their support for a Cochise County food drive;

WHEREAS, since that time, Cochise County employees have organized and volunteered to coordinate a food drive—known as “***Thanksgiving in June***” to collect non-perishable food items for donation to the Emergency Food & Shelter Local Recipient Organizations (LROs);

WHEREAS, on April 12th, the Emergency Food & Shelter Local Board met and heartily endorsed the idea and agreed to be responsible for the division and transport of all food items collected;

NOW THEREFORE, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors declares the Month of June to be “Thanksgiving in June” and authorizes establishing collection points throughout County offices;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Cochise County staff are encouraged to donate their time to solicit collections (for donation to the EFSP LROs) at participating stores on June 11, 2011 and June 25, 2011 throughout Cochise County.

Background:

May is the nationally recognized Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month. Due to its very favorable, nearly year-round riding conditions, Cochise County is a favorite destination for motorcyclists from all over Arizona as well as other parts of the country. There are more registered motorcycles on the road than ever before, and while motorcycle fatalities have very recently declined, there are still far too many crashes that result in the death or serious injury of riders. The most common problem for crashes involving other motor vehicles (about 3/4 of all crashes), is that the drivers of vehicles do not see motorcycles. The purpose of today's Proclamation and related events at the County are to 1) raise driver awareness of motorcycles sharing the roadway and the risks posed to them (and other motorists) from distracted driving, 2) to encourage all riders to become properly trained in a Motorcycle Safety Foundation-approved course and to wear proper gear at all times when riding, 3) to acknowledge and encourage the use of motorcycles as a means to reducing fuel consumption and 4) to help 'humanize' motorcyclists so that other drivers remember that "Real People Ride" -- people with families and jobs who contribute to society.

With the approval of this grant application, the Housing Authority will be providing the FSS Program for the sixth consecutive year. This program is designed to Section 8 HCV families with supportive services such as education, transportation, child care, counseling, and personal development. The families have five years to complete the goals and objectives outlined in their case plans and to build an escrow account to use toward goals such as a down payment on a home or education.
