AMENDMENT THREE

The **Agreement** entered into between the **Cochise County Board of Supervisors**, hereinafter referred to as the **County**, and the Director of the **Arizona Department of Corrections**, for and on behalf of the **Arizona State Prison Complex– Douglas**, hereinafter known as the **Department** is hereby amended as follows:

This Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

Based on and in accordance with Section 3.4 of the Agreement, the Preliminary Engineering Study has been completed and the parties have met and agreed on the following cost and scope of the renovation. Based on the Preliminary Engineering Study, finalization of the renovation project has not been determined at this time.

It is agreed that the renovation improvements to be completed at this time will be based on an 87/13 percent split between ADC and the County with the Department agreeing to pay \$249,000.00 of the costs listed below. The renovations stated below are considered the most critical in keeping the system operational, improving water quality and providing the needed water capacity for the prison.

1. Upgrade of Existing Electrical Panels, Wells 7 & 8	\$ 60,000
2. Install Telemetry & Well Controls	\$ 20,000
3. Upgrades to the Existing Disinfection System	\$ 30,000
4. Misc. Valving, System Isolation & Pipe works	\$ 25,000
5. Replacement of the Check Valve (Main Line)	\$ 25,000
6. Altitude Valve (Elevated Tank)	\$ 75,000
7. Engineering	\$ 25,000
Sub-total:	\$ 260,000
Contingency 10%	\$ 26,000
TOTAL:	\$ 286,000

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All other terms and conditions of this Contract shall remain in full force and effect.
