Background

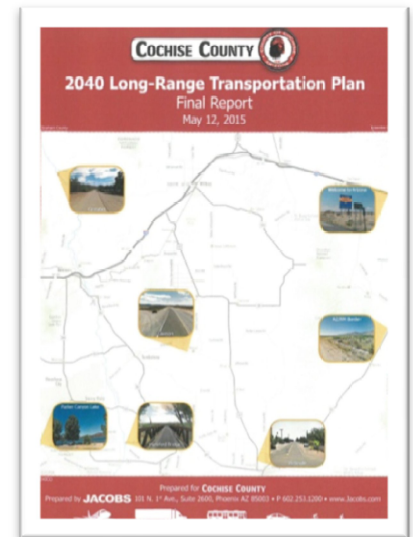
Provides for consistent design standards and specifications for the County's roadway network.

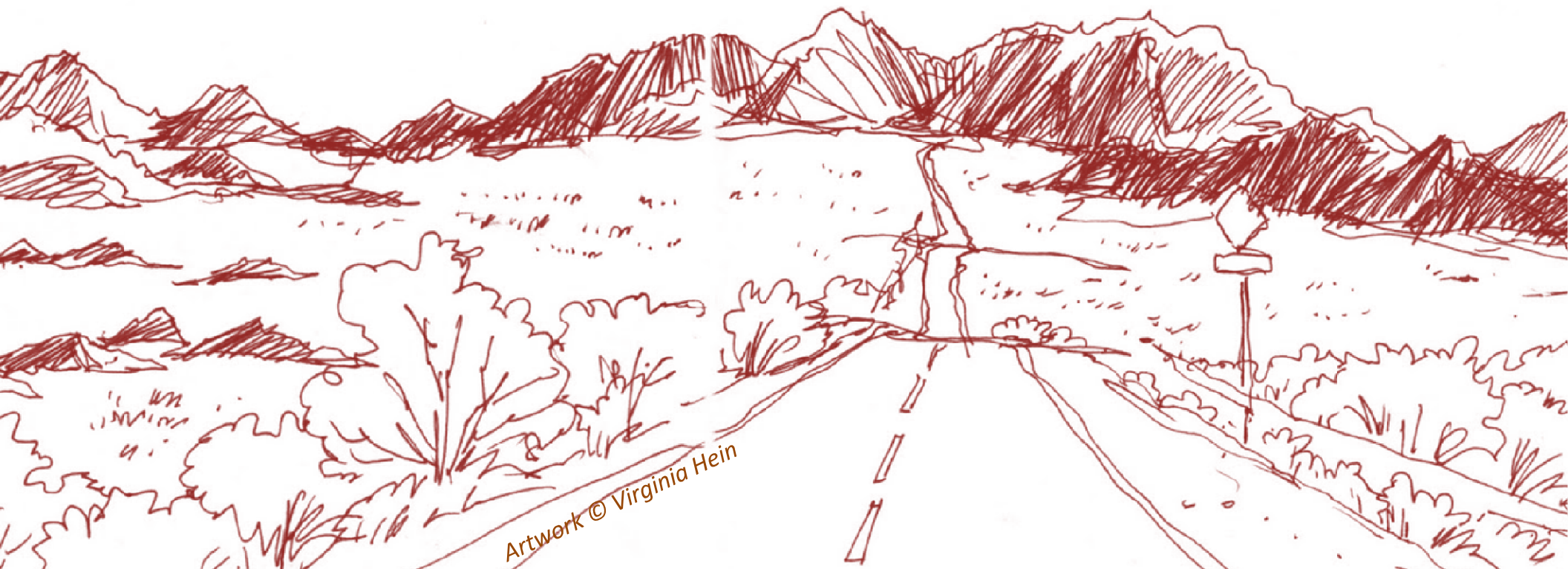
