**Board of Supervisors**

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of August 8, 2017.
2. Ratify a Letter of Congratulations to Chief Emeritus Lee Edward Lewis, San Jose Fire District for his service to his community during his 40 year involvement with the fire district.

**County Schools**

3. Approve Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) SABG-GR-16-040116-01 between the Arizona State Office of Youth, Faith, & Family and the Cochise County School Superintendent's Office for substance abuse prevention for the period of April 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016 in the amount of \$20,000.

Chairman English noted that there was typos and the correct agreement number was SABG-GR-17-040117-02 and the correct dates were July 1, 2017 through September 30, 2017.

4. Approve Amendment 2 to Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) SABG-GR-16-040116-02 between the Arizona State Office of Youth, Faith, & Family and the Cochise County School Superintendent's Office for substance abuse prevention for the period of October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017 in the amount of \$40,000.

5. Adopt Resolution 17-16 authorizing Cochise County Treasurer to collect and disburse the property taxes for 2017.

6. Approve amendment 1 to the contract with Revolutionary Text, LLC for remote reporting services.

### **Finance**

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve items 1-7 on the consent agenda. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

### ***PUBLIC HEARINGS***

### **Board of Supervisors**

8. [ITEM TABLED FROM AUGUST 8, 2017 MEETING]: Adopt Resolution 17-13 granting a Telecommunications and Fiber Optic Services franchise to Level 3 Communications, LLC.

Supervisor Judd moved to remove the item from the table. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mr. Hanson presented this item. Mr. Hanson noted that the applicant had agreed to the changes in the legal wording proposed by the County Attorney's Office and staff was recommending approval of the franchise.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to adopt Resolution 17-13 granting a Telecommunications and Fiber Optic Services franchise to Level 3 Communications, LLC. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

## **ACTION**

### **Board of Supervisors**

9. Approve Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) 2017-081 between the Department of Public Safety (DPS) and Cochise County in the amount of \$166,666 to be used for prosecutorial and jail expenses incurred from individuals charged with drug trafficking, human smuggling, illegal immigration and other border related crime.

Ms. Rios explained that DPS had requested this MOU to be administered by the Board since the funding was being split between two elected offices. She noted that representatives from the Attorney's Office and the Sheriff's Office were present to answer any questions regarding the use of the funding.

Supervisor Judd moved to Approve Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) 2017-081 between the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) and Cochise County in the amount of \$166,666 to be used for prosecutorial and jail expenses incurred from individuals charged with drug trafficking, human smuggling, illegal immigration and other border related crime. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English asked Mr. McIntyre if he knew what percentage of the total costs accrued by criminal attorneys handling these cases this funding would cover.

Mr. McIntyre said he did not have an exact percentage, but noted that the funding would offset costs generally paid for by the County's general fund. He added that he could provide a report on cases dealing with these issues.

Chairman English asked Commander Bradshaw about projects in the jail that this funding would impact.

Commander Bradshaw said that funding had been used for some security upgrades and would be used to pay for costs directly related to the 17% of inmates who are not US Citizens. He offered to also send a report to the Board showing jail demographics.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

## Community Development

10. Adopt Resolution 17-17 updating the Cochise County Road Design and Construction Standards and Specifications for Public Improvements.

Ms. Karen Lamberton, County Transportation Officer, Community Development, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Lamberton gave the background and noted that a work session had been held in June to discuss the proposed changes. She noted that there had been a lot of feedback and most of it was positive. At this time staff recommended adoption of this update and added that this was a great tool for our employees and citizens to better communicate. She stated that the new standards reflect changes and improvements in road technologies over the past 14 years. She reported that the update included 6 revised roadway sections, 1 new roadway cross section, and 40 updated design details along with a revised narrative and specifications consistent with nationally recognized standards and procedures.

The Board thanked staff for their work on this update.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to adopt Resolution 17-17 updating the Cochise County Road Design and Construction Standards and Specifications for Public Improvements. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

## County Schools

11. Approve Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) No. SABG-GR-18-070117-02 between the State of Arizona Governor's Office of Youth, Faith, and Family and the Cochise County School Superintendent's Office to provide guidance and direction for five schools for the Healthy Families/Healthy Youth Pilot Program for the period of July 1, 2017 through September 30, 2017 in the amount of \$98,835.

Ms. Debbie Prow, County School's Office, presented this item. She gave the background on the IGA and said that this grant was focused on teaching parents on the best way to communicate with their children about drug and alcohol abuse. She stated that the grant would be serving 5 schools in the County.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) No. SABG-GR-18-070117-02 between the State of Arizona Governor's Office of Youth, Faith, and Family and the Cochise County School Superintendent's Office to provide guidance and direction for five schools for the Healthy Families/Healthy Youth Pilot Program for the period of July 1, 2017 through September 30, 2017 in the amount of \$98,835. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

## Facilities

12. Approve Airport Improvement Plan Grant Offer #3-04-0013-011-2017 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the amount of \$741,497 with a local match share of \$37,075 for the Reconstruction of Taxiway A at the Bisbee Douglas International (BDI) Airport.

Mr. Jay Howe, Facilities Director, presented this item. Mr. Howe said that this was for the reconstruction and noted that there would be a county match, which would also be matched by

the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT).

Vice-Chairman Call amended the motion to approve Airport Improvement Plan Grant Offer #3-04-0013-011-2017 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the amount of \$741,497 with a local match share of \$36,399.01 for the Reconstruction of Taxiway A at the Bisbee Douglas International (BDI) Airport. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

***REPORT BY EDWARD T. GILLIGAN COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS***

Mr. Gilligan said that staff was currently conducting interviews for the Highway and Floodplain Director position and those should be finalized in September with a recommendation on an offer to the best candidate.
