

The Library District's existing mission statement is out of date:

***The mission of the Cochise County Library District is to provide essential support services for the seven member city libraries, effective management of the branches and bookmobiles which serve rural residents, and leadership in the development of public library services countywide.***

Library staff members have worked together to come up with new mission statement ideas that reflect why our work is important, rather than simply listing the work we perform.

Ideally, the new statement should be brief enough that everyone can remember it. The language should also be broad enough to include the work we do to support member libraries as well as the services we provide for the public.

We have narrowed the possibilities down to three, and would like guidance from the Board of Supervisors before selecting one:

- ***We enrich our communities by providing equal access to opportunities to learn, relax, grow, and connect.***
- ***The mission of the Cochise County Library District is to facilitate lifelong learning, inspiration, discovery, and community.***
- ***The joy of reading. The discovery of ideas. The power of information.***
